**Supply List: (This is option. You don't have to provide these things unless you want to. I'll be doing them all in class for us.)**

Monday

Letter-Blank Letter K sheet, cut out kite shapes from construction paper, glue

Art – Colorful tissue paper cut into small squares, glue, contact paper-if it's for the window like stained glass (or just regular paper)

Science-Straw, balloon, tape, \*straight pin (\*Requires adult supervision)



Tuesday

Letter-Blank Letter L, words cut from a magazine, scissors

Art – cardstock, markers, small piece of ribbon, hole punch

Wednesday

Letter-Blank Letter M, markers, googly eyes

Art – old knit glove, buttons, cotton stuffing (or other stuffing material), glue (\*hot glue works best, which will require an adult to close up the top of the glove after stuffing)

Science – balloon, marker, water bottle, vinegar and baking soda



Thursday

Letter-Blank Letter N,

Art – clear water bottle, beads or other noise makers, ribbon (optional)



Friday

Letter-Blank Letter O,

Art – plastic jar, 5 pieces of construction paper (light to dark), small plastic sea creatures toys, string, ocean animal stickers (optional)
