



PALM SUNDAY LESSON

Good news, good news! Jesus is coming to town, Jesus is coming to town! **Show newspaper.** Say, They didn't have newspapers back then, but word did get around that Jesus was coming.

The people thought, "Let's roll out the red carpet for Him!" **Quickly spread paper out like rug.** But, they didn't have a red carpet back then, so what else could they do to welcome Him?

Begin rolling the newspaper into a tube as you talk.

Suddenly, the people said, "Here He comes! Here comes Jesus riding into town on a young donkey like a King. If only we had a trumpet, we could give Him a royal welcome!" **Blow into the rolled paper and make trumpet sounds.**

What could they do to welcome Jesus? **Cut 4 slits in end of paper tube.** They sat down in the grass to think. **Shake paper tube so cut pieces resemble grass.**

The people looked up at the tall palm trees. **Pull the newspaper tree up tall as shown in video demonstration.** They had an idea!

They said, "Let's wave palm branches to welcome Jesus!" They each plucked off a palm branch. **Pick off a piece of paper for each student.**

They waved their branches and shouted, "Hosanna," which means save us. **Wave your "palm branch" as we sing the song, Hosanna.**
