

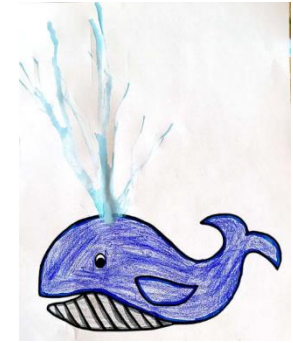

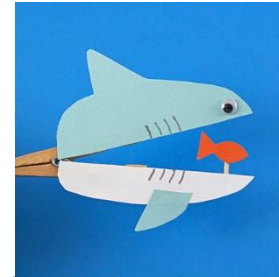
Monday –

Thursday –

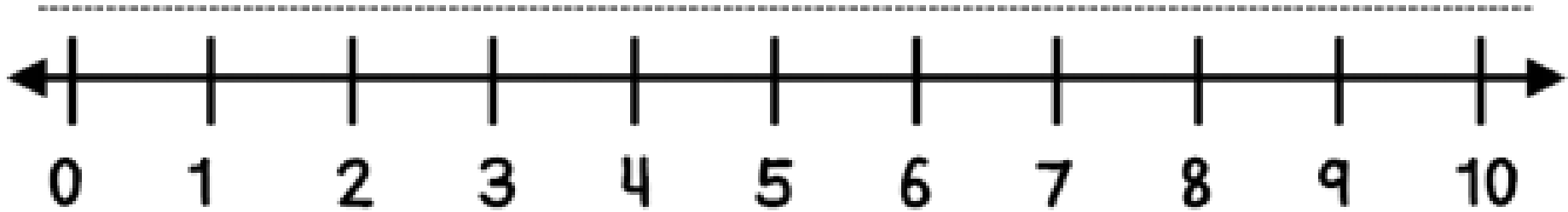
paper plate, marker/crayon/paint, streamers or other

items such as shells, glitter, beads, foam fish, etc.





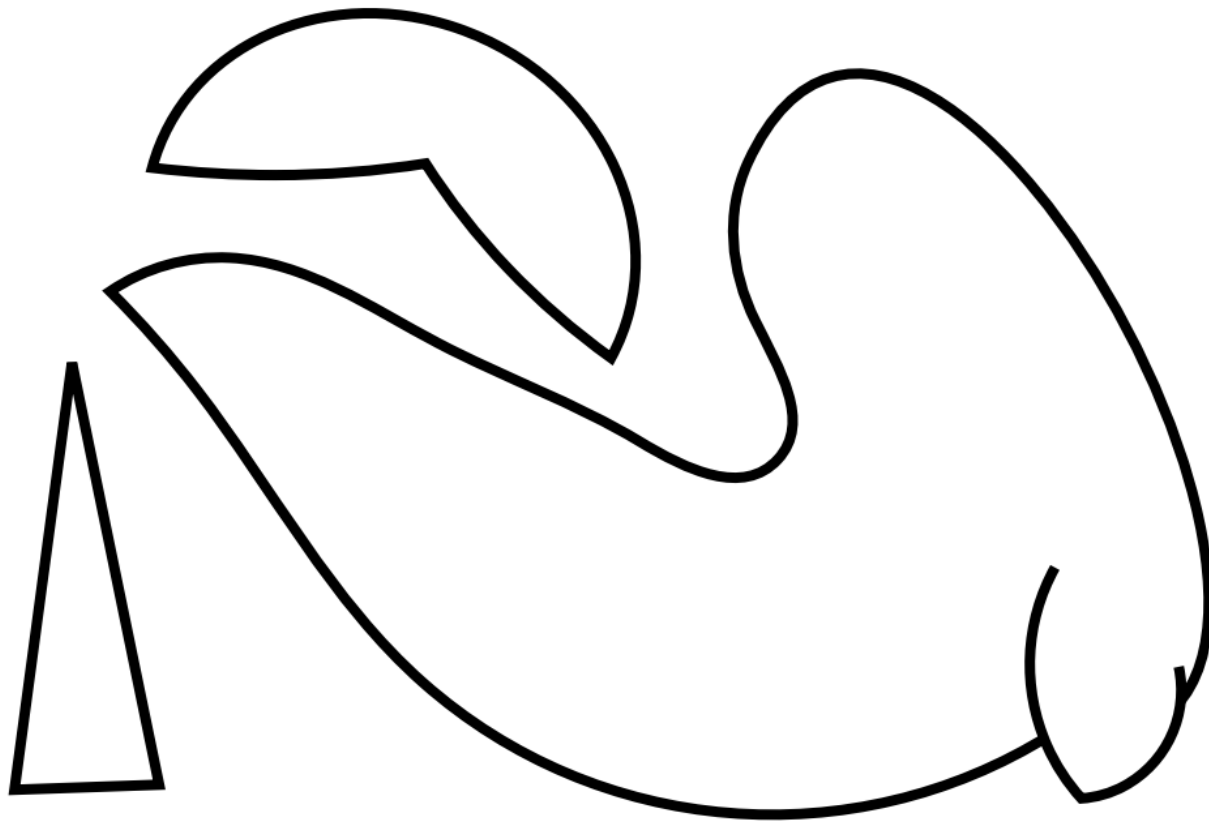
