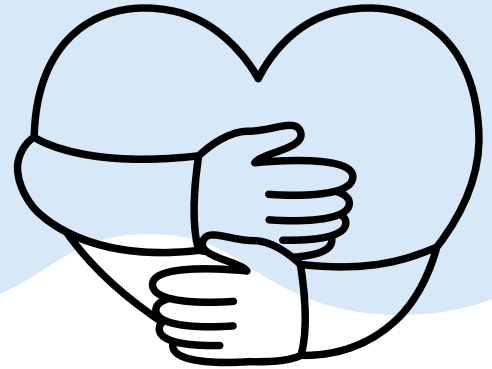


JESUS PROMISED A COMFORTER WOULD COME

Create Curiosity:

If your preschool class is near the baby room, you will undoubtedly hear babies crying. Say, the babies in the baby room miss their mommies and daddies. The teachers are trying to comfort them. They will rock them, give them their pacifier or rattle, put them in the baby swing, walk them around in the stroller, etc.



Teaching Time: John 14:16

Jesus walked and talked and preached and healed along side the disciples for three years.

After spending a lot of time with them, He told them it was almost time for Him to return to His Father in heaven.

He knew that they would miss Him! But, He told them that God would send someone to comfort them - the Holy Spirit.

Read John 14:16.

Do you ever miss someone? Like when you go back to school or daycare?

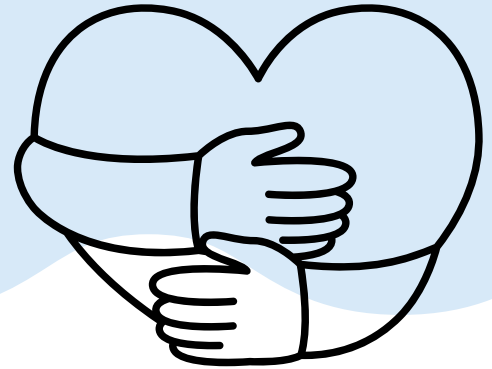
