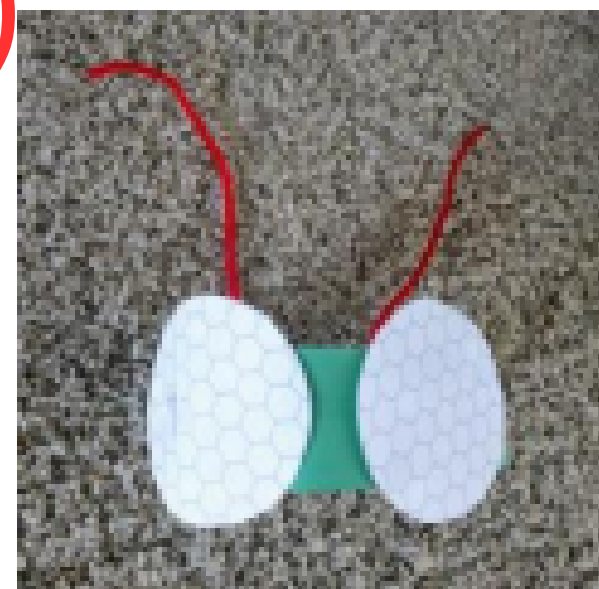
Supply List:

Tuesday –

Wednesday –

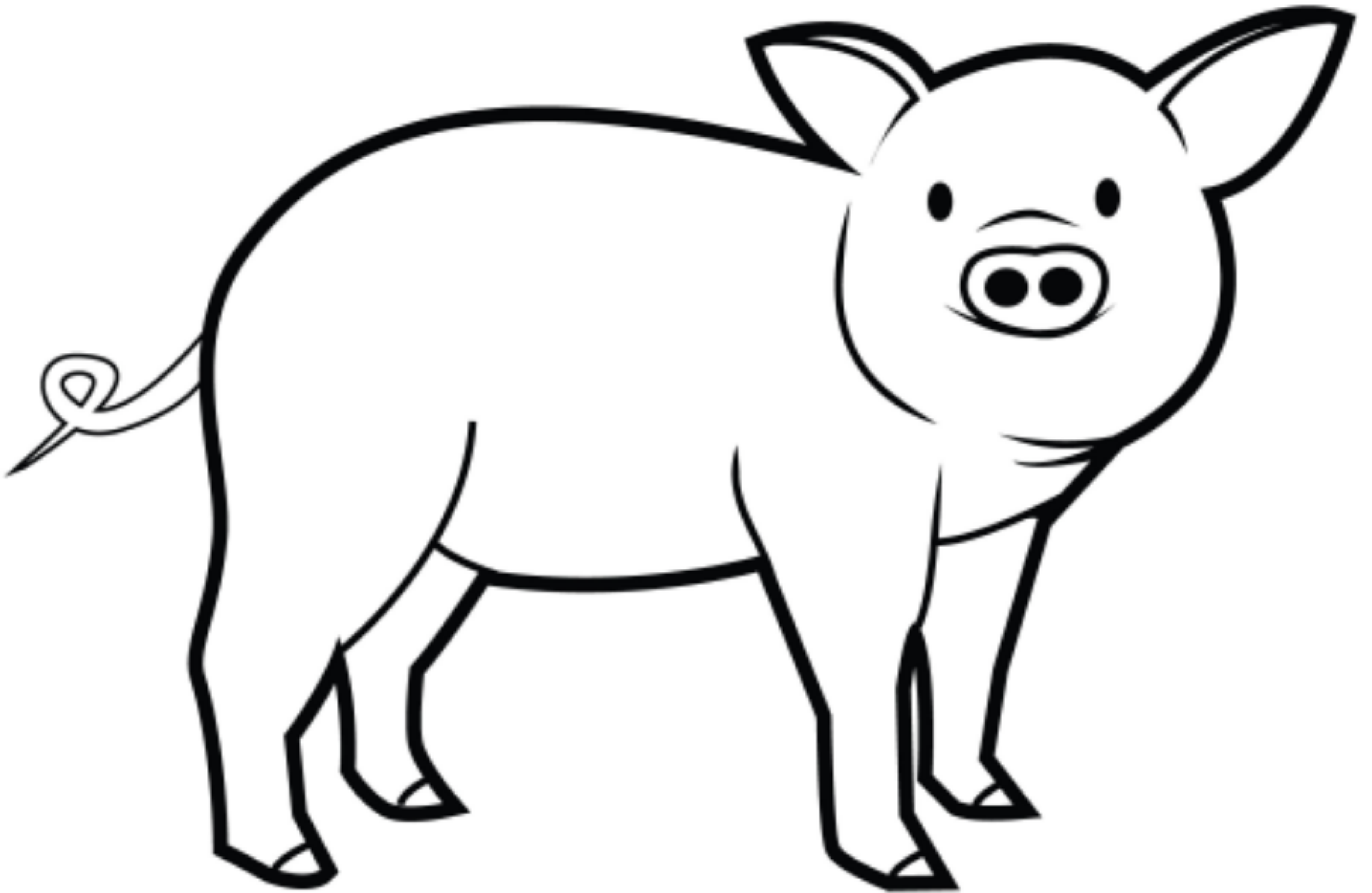
Various fabric cut into small squares, glue, green paper, 2 red pipe cleaners, cricket eyes printable

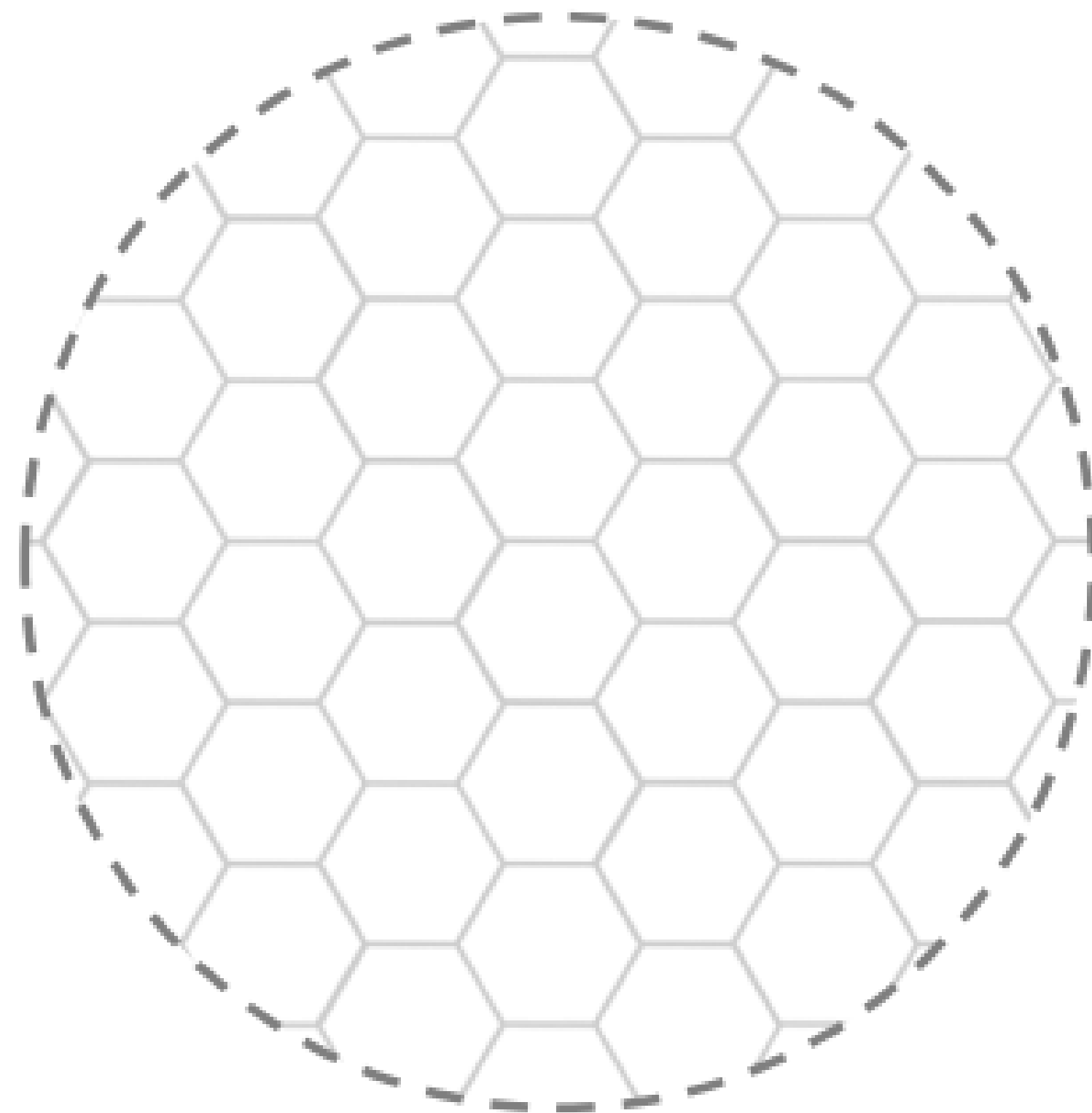
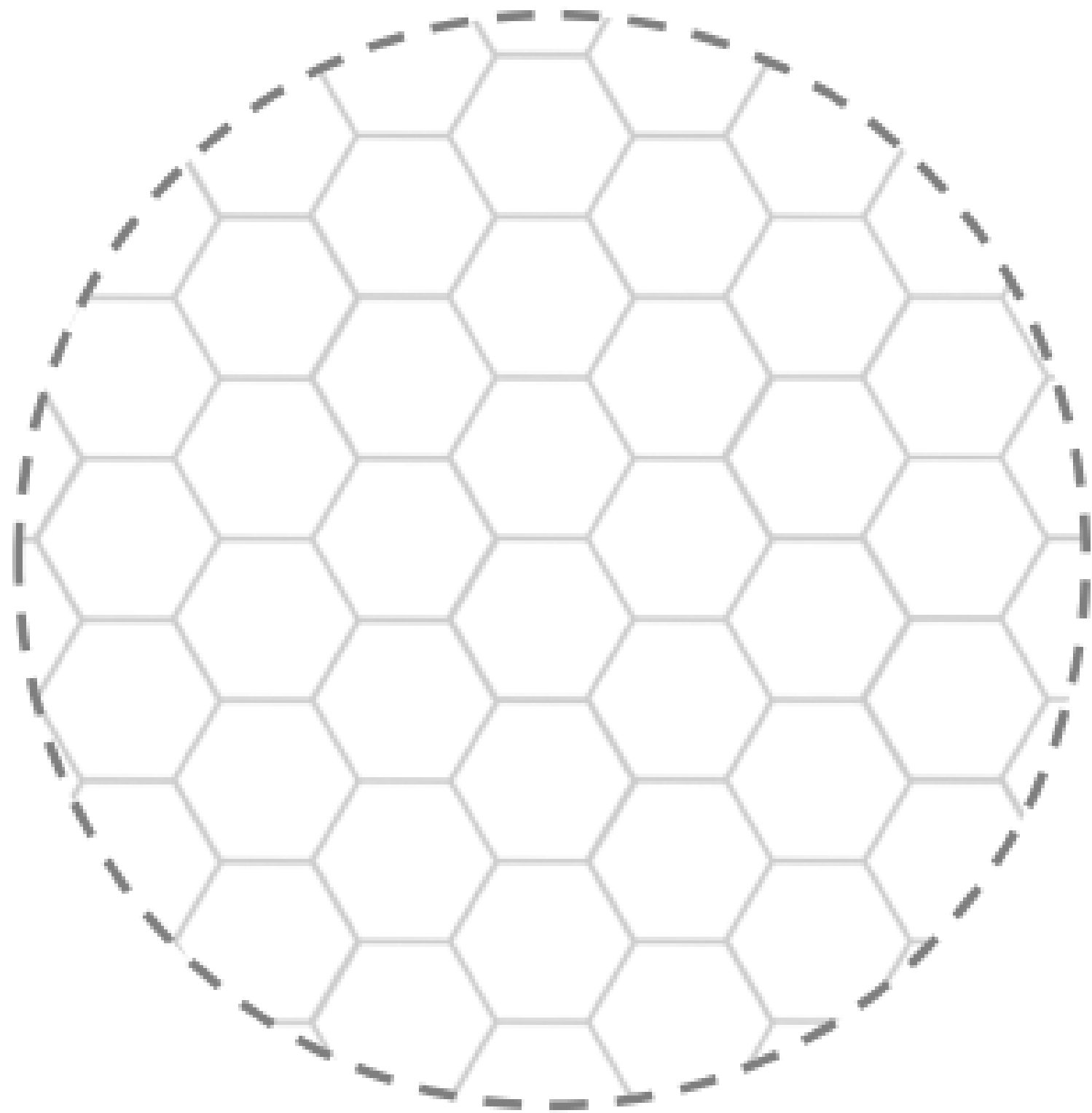

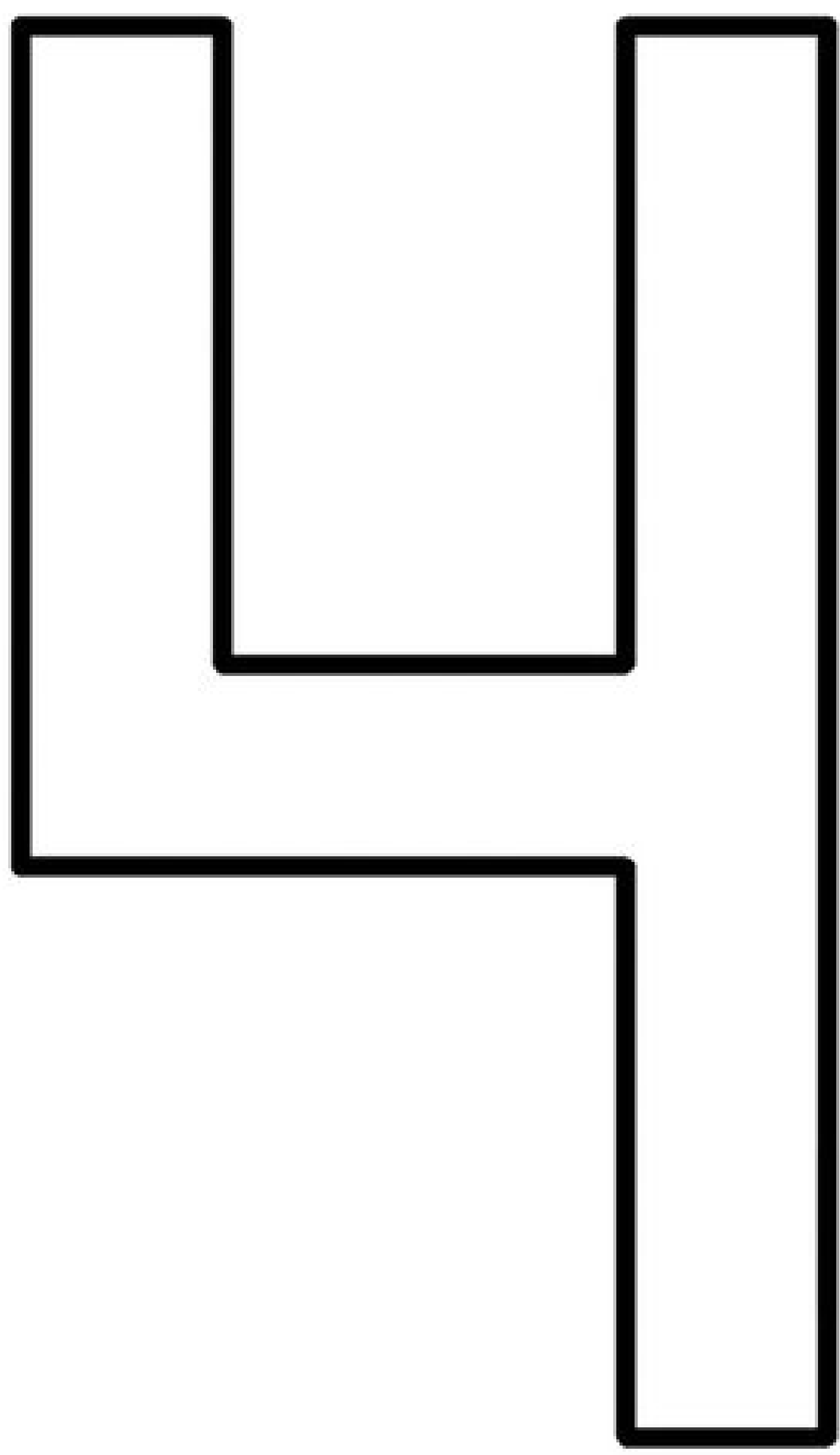
