### Review Packet


Use today as a Review Day. Here is how to use this Math Review Packet:

- 1- **Number Flashcards** Show child the number and see if they can tell you what it is.
- 2- Number Picture Stories and Flashcards Show child the card and tell the story. Have child count the pictures on each number. This teaches number sense: understanding the number and value and one to one correspondence.
- 3- Adding Use the number picture flashcards for adding, if your child is ready. Show two numbers and have them count the pictures on both to get the total.
- 4- **Counting** Have child count as his as they can. Teach them numbers up to 20.

## Number Flashcards

#### Number 1


When I was a kid, you could buy candy for 1 cent. I used to love to go into the store and buy one grape lollipop for 1 cent. Act it out: Hold up one finger and pretend it is a lollipop.



#### Number 2

Number two looks like a nose. Once a bee stung me on the nose. The bee stung me on the tip of my nose and at the back of it (where your nose attaches to your face). I got two big red bumps on my nose, one on the tip of my nose and one at the back of my nose!

Act it out: Grab your nose and say, Ouch!"



#### Number 3


I saw three orange monarchs flying near my car. One flew on top of my car, one flew at my front window and one flew under my car.

Act it out: Move your hand to show up, middle and under...kind of like making a number 3 in front of you.



#### Number 4

One day, I needed to climb a ladder to get something. The only ladder I had was an old wooden one. I noticed that part of the ladder had already fallen apart and 4 boards were loose on the top and part of the ladder.



#### Number 5

I was eating blueberry jelly and I got so messy! I got jelly on both my eyes, on my elbow, on my belly button and on my foot!


Act it out: Point to the parts of your body when mentioned in

the story.

#### Number 6

I went with my church on a mission trip. We visited another country where people wore lots of earrings! I saw a lady with 6 golden earrings – three on top of her ear and three more on the bottom (two on the side and one where it should be in the middle of her earlobe.) Show your child how to use the earrings to count by threes. I recommend this skip-counting technique when learning larger numbers like 6, 8-10)


Act it out: Hold your ear.



#### Number 7

I was staying with my cousins. There were 7 of us total so we slid the beds together and slept crossways. Three cousins slept on one bed and four on the other.


Act it out: Use actual cousin names to help with visualization.



#### Number 8

Once I made a snowman. My snowman looked so cold! I decide to put two pairs of earmuffs and two pairs of mittens on him! (Show your child how to use the earmuffs and mittens to count by twos. I recommend this skip-counting technique when learning larger numbers like 6, 8-10)

Act it out: Rub your hands together to show your are cold.




#### Number 9

I cut a flower and brought it inside and put it in a vase. It started to droop over to one side. The petals started to fall off. There were three petals on top, three on the bottom and

three on the floor. (Show your child how to use the flower to count by threes. I recommend this skip-counting technique when learning larger numbers like 6, 8-10)


Act it out: Pretend you are smelling the flower.



#### Number 10

The sun was shining so bright one day. There were nine rays around the sun, but one had broken off. (Show your child how to use sun rays to count by two and arrive at 10. Show him that there were two rays on the top left, two more on the top right, two on the bottom left, two more on the bottom right and one on the right, but the one on the left was broken off and standing beside the sun.)

Act it out: Spread your fingers apart like a bright sunshine...you have 10 fingers, just like the rays on the number 10.
