
## AQUILA & PRISCILLA

## **Create Curiosity:**

Create a simple tent in your classroom. You could use a sheet and chairs. OR suspend your tent from the ceiling. (These directions are for those whose church has ceiling tiles: Put a safety pin in the middle of the tent. Put a piece of yarn through the safety pin. Lift ceiling tile and loop the yarn though and tie in a knot. Stretch out and tuck the 4 corners of the sheet into the ceiling by gently lifting the corner of the ceiling tile.

Show your open Bible as you teach. Say, The Bible is true and it's for you!



Then they stayed in Ephesus. There was a man there named Apollos. He was speaking about Jesus. Aquila and Priscilla taught him what Paul had taught them. He was happy to know more. He continued to teach others about Jesus and all that he had learned.
