Paper plate, colorful paper, glue, scissors

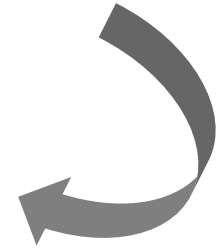
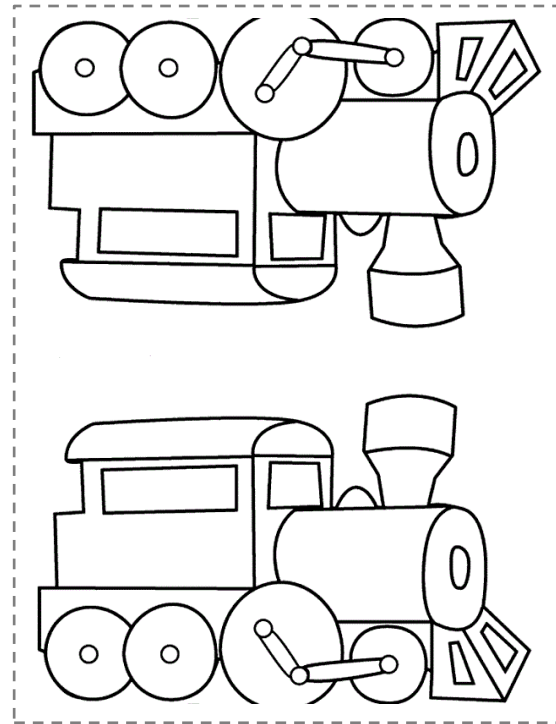


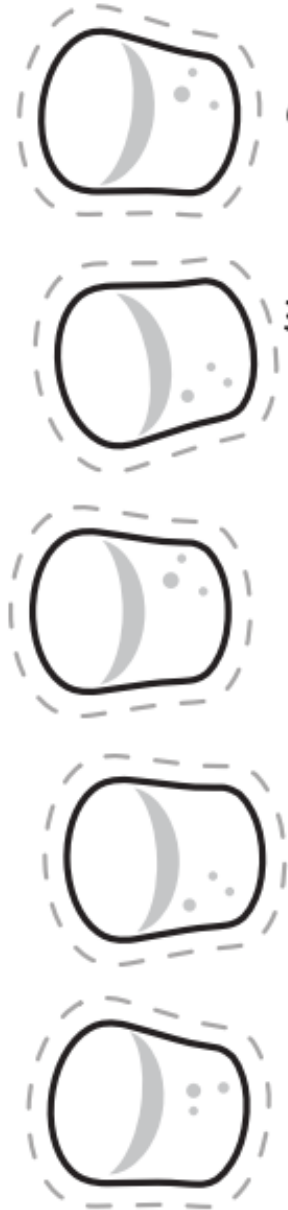

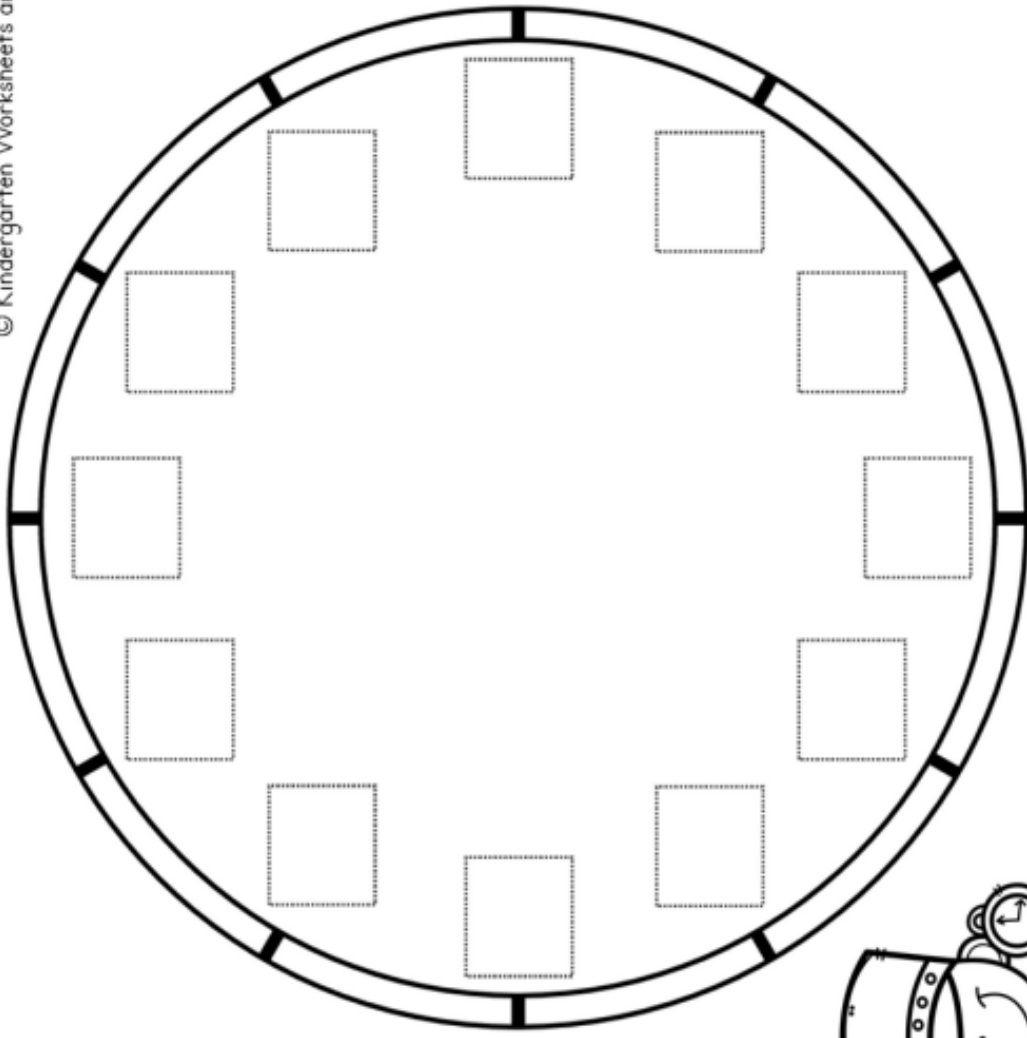


Cut out and tape to a hot wheels Car, if you don't have a toy train.

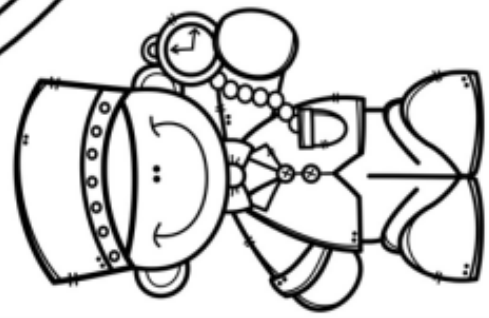

- Pose him however you want, there is no wrong or right way to build a snowman!

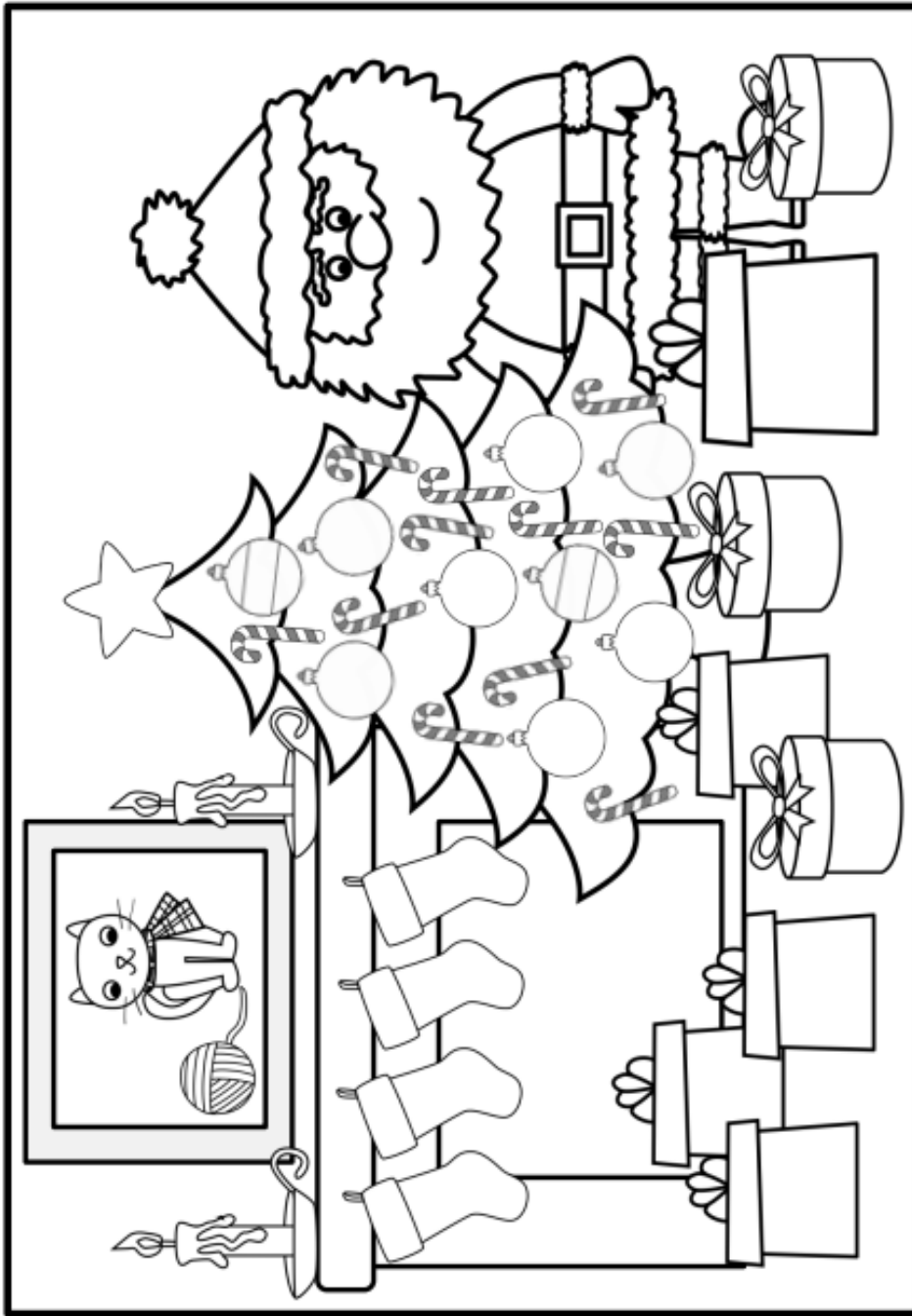
