Sunday School Lesson



Create Curiosity: Create a "store" at the front of the room on a small table. Place a necklace, party hat, and gift bag there. Teaching Time: Luke 15 Act out the story.

Jesus was the best teacher ever! He often used stories to teach a lesson. The Bible tells us in Luke 15 about a story that Jesus told.

Jesus told about a man who had 2 sons. One of the sons came to his dad and said, "I want my inheritance now."

[Have the volunteer hold out his hand and give him 3 plastic coins or use Monopoly money.]

[Have the volunteer walk up to the "store" and hand you one coin as you put the necklace around his neck. Have him give you one coin as you put the party hat on. Have him give you one coin as you give him the gift bag.]

The boy spent all his money buying nice things to wear, throwing big parties and giving his friends lavish gifts.

Soon the money ran out! He had none left! He was hungry so he had to sell the nice things he had bought.

[Have the student put the items back on the table.]

The boy had no money left. He got a job feeding pigs.

[Have the volunteer pretend to feed pigs as all the students make pig noises.]

He thought, "I'm so hungry, wish I could eat what these pigs are eating! My fathers servants have a better life than me!"

He began to think about going back home. Surely his father would be mad at him. He had left home, wasted all his money, and made some bad choices. He decided to give it a try.


[Have the volunteer begin to walk back to other side of the room where the father had given him the money at the beginning.]

When the father saw the son coming from far away, he ran to meet him and hugged him tightly! He said, "Bring a robe and ring and prepare a feast! We will celebrate because my son is home!" [**Hug the volunteer.**]

Jesus told this story to teach us that God loves us so much! Nothing we can do will make him stop loving us! And when we do wrong and tell Him we are sorry, He always forgives us.

Teaching Time: Daniel 3

Three men named Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, knew that we are only to pray to God. They would not bow down and pray to the statue.

Create Curiosity:

Show a candy cane. Ask the kids what it is. They will say, Candy cane. Tell them alternate names are sugar stick, shepherd's crook, peppermint stick, and sweet cane. When candy canes were first invented they were called sugar sticks. A choirmaster wanted to keep the children quiet at churchduring a Christmas eve performance, so he asked a local candy maker for some "sugar sticks" to give them. He told the candy maker to add a crook to remind them of the shepherds who visited baby Jesus.

Teaching Time: Isaiah 9:6, & 7:14

Show the Bible as you teach. Tell the kids that the Bible is God's book. It is true and it's for you!

In Bible times, the word name could refer to a title. A title is what you call someone, but not their actual name. For example, you call your parents, Mom and Dad, but that is not their actual name.

Sometimes we assign multiple names to people. What do you call your grandparents? (allow responses)

The proper name for Jesus is Jesus! The Bible also calls Him: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace, Immanuel. Immanuel means, God with us! God loved us so much that He sent His Son, Jesus to be with us!



Show your open Bible as you teach. Say, The Bible is true and it's for you!



Teaching Time: Acts 1-2

Show your open Bible as you teach. Say, The Bible is true and it's for you!

It was a special holiday and the disciples and some other people had gathered in a house. They were praying. All of a sudden, they heard a sound like a loud blowing wind. The sound filled the house. God's Spirit had come! He caused them to be able to speak in different languages. A crowd gathered from all over the place. They could understand what was being said! They wondered, How is it that we hear, each of us in his own native language (verse 8)? We hear them telling in our own languages the mighty works of God (verse 11). All were amazed and wondered, "What does this mean? (verse 12)" Peter stood up and preached. Everyone understood what he said. He told them that God loves them. He sent Jesus to take the punishment for out sin. He died on the cross, rose and went to heaven. About 3,000 people were there who believed what Peter was saying. The people were from all over. This shows us that God loves everybody all over the world! Jesus died for them all!


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

ADAM AND EVE SINNED, BUT GOD FORGIVES



Teaching Time: Genesis 2

Show your open Bible. Say, The Bible tells us about Adam and Eve, the first people God created. God placed them in a beautiful garden. There were trees everywhere!

God told them they could eat from all the trees in the garden, except one. That's a lot of trees they could eat from!

Say, They could choose this one, or this one, or this one... (point to each one around the room as you are talking).

Adam and Eve made a bad choice. Even though they had so many trees to choose from, they chose to eat from the <u>one</u> tree God said not to. [Show an apple and make a slice out of the side of it using a butter knife. Pretend the eat the apple slice.]

When Adam and Eve disobeyed, it hurt their friendship with God. The punishment for sin is separation from God. God did not want them to sin. He told them not to. He did not want to be separated from them. So He had a plan! God's plan was to send Jesus to heal the broken relationship caused by sin. [Place a Band-Aid over the cut apple.] God's love and forgiveness allows us to be in a loving friendship with Him, even when we make mistakes.





He loves you so much that He gave His Son to take our punishment for sin by dyeing on the cross. That's how much He loves you!

Teaching Time: John 4

Show your Bible. Say, The Bible tells us about when Jesus was on His way to his hometown.

He passed through Samaria. He sat down by a well. [Direct kids to a beach bucket filled with water.]

It was noon so the sun was directly overhead. It was hot! Usually people came to the well to get water in the early morning when it was cooler. [Instruct kids to "fan yourself" with your hand OR blow a battery hand fan on the kids.]

A woman came to the well during this hottest time of day to get water. Jesus was there waiting. [Dip your water pail into the water.] Jesus talked to her! He asked her for a drink of water. He knew everything about her; even the bad things she had done. She realized that He was the Messiah; Savior of the world. She left her water jar and went to tell people in her town about Jesus. [Sat water pail down.]

God loves everyone - no matter who they are or what they've done. God has a "No Matter What" kind of love!

We should have that same kind of love for others too!

A man named Zacchaeus wanted to see Jesus. He was short and could not see over everyone else. He ran ahead and climbed up in a tree. He scooted out onto the branch so he could have a bird's eye view of Jesus when He passed by.

Zacchaeus was a tax collector. That means that his job was to collect money from the people. Sometimes he took too much money from them. When people saw Zacchaeus coming, they usually turned around and went the opposite way!

When Jesus arrived at the place where Zacchaeus was up in the tree, He looked up at him and said, Zacchaeus, come down. I want to visit you at your house today. Zacchaeus hurried down! Wow! Jesus saw him! Jesus told him who He was and how to be saved. Zacchaeus believed. Zacchaeus said, I will give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount."



Have the children sit in a circle on the floor. Have one child sit in a chair with his back to the audience and clow eyes. Give one child a large plastic coin or Monopoly bill and have them quietly sneak up and put the coin under the chair. The child in the chair much guess who gave them the money.

Teaching Time: Matthew 6

Show your Bible. Say, The Bible tells us that Jesus taught about how we should live.

Jesus said when you <u>give to someone in need, keep it a secret</u>. Don't tell everybody so that you look good and people reward you. Instead, God will reward you.

Jesus said <u>forgive others</u>. Let's practice. You say, I'm sorry. I'll say, I forgive you. Repeat and switch roles. Remind children we must forgive in our hearts, not just with our words.

Jesus taught <u>not to worry</u>. Show an artificial flower (or picture). Ask, Who is more important to God this flower or you? You! Show toy bird (or picture). Ask, Who is more important to God this bird or you? You!


Have you ever seen a bird planting a garden or storing vegetables in their little barn? No! God makes sure they find food.



The story comes from the Bible in Luke 8. (show open Bible)


Jesus had been traveling around preaching and teaching. The people gathered all around him as he was walking on the street.







Create Curiosity:

Have students wiggle fingers, bend elbows, reach up high, nod head, rotate ankles, bend knees, walk in place... Explain that in today's lesson, a man could not walk.

Teaching Time: Mark 2: 1-12

One day, Jesus was teaching in a house. More and more people came to hear him. The house became very crowded. There was no more room, not even at the door.

[Have children stand and huddle close together. Point out how crowded it is.]

When Jesus saw the man's faith, He told him... Read Mark 2: 5.


Jesus told the man, "Rise, pick up your bed, and go home," (verse 11).

The disciples woke Jesus up. [Child on pillow should stand up.] They said, Don't you care that this big storm is going to sink our boat!



Teaching Time: Luke 5



Woman at the Well Sunday School Lesson

Create Curiosity:

Create a paper "well" and tape to the side of a table. On the table, place small cups of water. Have the children

walk to the well and get a drink and sit down for the lesson.



Teaching Time:

Jesus and his disciples were traveling and teaching people about God. They traveled through Samaria. The disciples went to buy food. Jesus stayed by a well.

Long ago, people did not have running water from a sink in their homes. They would have to go and get water with a bucket at the well and carry it back home.

While he was sitting there, a woman came to get water from the well.

Jesus asked her for some water.

The woman couldn't believe Jesus was talking to her. She had done a lot of bad things. No one wanted to talk to her.

Jesus said, If you knew who I was, you'd be asking Me for living water.

She said, You don't have a bucket to put water in!

Jesus said he was talking about something that satisfies better than water you drink. He was talking about eternal life in heaven with God.

Jesus told the woman all the bad things that she had done. She was amazed! How could he know all that! Only if He was someone very special.

Jesus said, I am the Messiah; the One who can save people from their sins.

She said, I want this living water. She left her water pot jar and ran and told everyone to, Come and see Jesus!

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Woman at the Well Sunday School Lesson

Craft Corner:

Medicine cup (or small cup0, hole punch, pipe cleaner, string, popsicle stick

Directions: Punch holes in the sides of the cup and fix the pipe cleaner like a handle. Tie one end of the string to the bucket handles and the other to a popsicle stick.

Allow kids to dip their bucket into a larger bucket of water to get water like the woman at the well.

Nicodemus Sunday School Lesson

Create Curiosity:

Show a large clear pitcher of water that is dirty (add dirt from outside in advance). Ask, do you think this water is good for drinking? (No!) Add scoops of clean water to the pitcher and ask if that's any better. (No.) Repeat several times. No matter how much clean water I add, the dirty water just won't get clean! In our story today, we will hear about a man named, Nicodemus. He thought that if he followed the rules and did good, it would be enough to wash his sins and give him eternal life in heaven. But, we cannot do enough good things to make us clean. Only Jesus can make us clean from our sins!

Teaching Time:

Turn off the lights and provide a lantern, lamp or flashlights to dimly light the room. Explain that Nicodemus came to visit Jesus at night.

Omit for very young: Why did he come at night? He probably didn't want anyone to see him talking to Jesus. He was a religious leader and religious leaders didn't like Jesus. They didn't believe He was God's Son.

Jesus talked with Nicodemus. One of the things he told him is a famous verse that most people memorize. Read John 3:16.

Jesus also told Nicodemus that if he wanted to have eternal life, he would have to be born again.

Nicodemus didn't understand. How could someone we born again?

Show your baby picture. Ask, Can I become a baby like in this photo again? (No.)

Explain that Jesus wasn't talking about being born physically, but spiritually. The only way to start over spiritually is to believe that Jesus is God's Son, who died on the cross to pay the wage for your sins.

Craft Corner:

What Can Wash Away My Sins? heart shaped craft Provide heart printable and red paint with Q-tips. Allow kids to paint the heart red.



Teaching Time:

The Bible tells us about a woman named, Hannah. Hannah wanted a baby more than anything else in the world. Year after year went by, but Hannah still did not have a baby of her own.

When Hannah and her husband went to the temple to worship, Hannah kneeled and prayed to God. She said, God please give me a baby. I will take care of him and teach him to love you. He will work for you all his life. Hannah and her husband went home.

One day, God gave Hannah a little baby boy, just as she had prayed for. Hannah was very happy. She named the baby, Samuel.

Hannah took good care of Samuel. She fed him and washed him and put clean clothes on him.

Jesus Called His Disciples

Create Curiosity:

Drop Everything and Follow SKIT: Gather stuffed animals into your arms until they are full. Say, I don't thing I can hold another thing! If I keep holding onto these things, I won't be able to add anything else.

Teaching Time:

Andrew and Simon were among the first disciples Jesus called. They were fishermen. (Be sure you still have the stuffed animals in your arms.) They had a lot of things in their lives that they loved: a boat, fishing nets, job, family, house... Jesus said, Follow Me. They dropped everything. (Dramatically drop all the stuffed animals.) They left their fish, their boat, and their family to follow Jesus.

Later, Jesus found a man named Philip. (Begin picking up the stuffed animals as you continue.) Philip had a lot of things he loved: family, house, job.... Jesus said, Follow Me. Philip also dropped everything to follow Jesus. He told his friend about Jesus too.

Philip went to get his friend, Nathanael, to bring him to Jesus. Earlier Nathanael had been sitting under a fig tree. Maybe he was watching a bird soar up in the sky or a butterfly flutter by. Maybe he was eating figs from the tree. Maybe he was praying. No one was around. He was all by himself.

Philip found him and said, We've found the Savior the Bible talks about! Come and see!

As they were going to see Jesus, Jesus recognized Nathanael. Nathanael said, How do you know me?

Read John 1:48-49 (Read from your own Bible to show the kids this story is from the Bible)
48 Nathanael said to him, "How do you know me?" Jesus answered him, "Before Philip called you, when you
were under the fig tree, I saw you." 49 Nathanael answered him, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God! You are the King
of Israel!" John 1:47-49, ESV

(Pick up the stuffed animals again.) Say, all these men had a lot of things they loved in their lives. But, if they held onto all those things, they would have missed the one thing that was much better!

(Drop all the smaller stuffed animals and replace it with one giant stuffed animal you had hidden.) This is so much better than all the rest, but I wouldn't have been able to hold it if I'd kept on holding onto all those other things. I would have missed the BEST!

Jesus is better than anything else!



Create Curiosity: Show a vegetable (such as broccoli) and a lollipop Ask, Which would you rather have? The vegetable is so good and healthy for us, but we want what tastes good - even if it's not good for our body or teeth and will make us sticky. That colorful, sweet lollipop is so tempting! Jesus was tempted too.

Teaching Time:

Jesus went off by Himself for 40 days to pray. He didn't eat anything during this time and He was hungry. The devil said, If You are God's Son, turn these stones into bread.

Jesus used the Bible like a weapon against the devil. Did he bonk him on the head with it? No! But, He used a Bible verse to shut the devil up.

Jesus said, The Bible says man shall not live by bread alone. Jesus knew God would take care of His needs. (Deuteronomy 8:3)

Then the devil took Jesus up to the top of the temple roof. He said, If You are God's Son, jump down and see if God sends angels to catch You!

Jesus used the Bible like a weapon against the devil. Did he bonk him on the head? No, but He used a Bible verse to shut the devil up.

Jesus said, The Bible says, Do not test God!" (Deuteronomy 6:16)

The devil took Jesus to a high mountain where they could see kingdoms far and wide. The devil said, I will give You all the money and power of these kingdoms. All You have to do is worship me! Jesus used the Bible like a weapon against the devil. Did he bonk him on the head? No, but He used a Bible verse to shut the devil up.

Jesus said, The Bible says, Worship only God. Go away! (Deuteronomy 6:13-14)

And the devil went away. The Bible says if we resist the devil, he will flee. (James 4:7)

Ask, Do you ever get tempted?

Does the devil tempt you to yell at mom and say, No! when she tells you to do something?

If you get tempted to disobey your parents, you can use the Bible against the devil. Say, The Bible says to honor your father and mother. (Exodus 20:12)

If you get tempted to push your brother, sister, or friend, you can use the Bible against the devil. Say, The Bible says we should be kind to one another. (Ephesians 4:32)

If you get tempted to take something that doesn't belong to you, you can use the Bible against the devil. Say, The Bible says, You should not steal. (Exodus 20:15)

Craft: Make a simple bookmark using construction paper and stickers or duct tape with sticky sides together.

Sing a Song: Sing, The B.I.B.L.E.

Attention Grabber:

Show a plastic baby doll. "Feed" the baby doll some baby food or similar. Be sure the baby food makes a mess on the baby doll. Put the baby doll into a baby bathtub and show the children that you are washing the baby clean.

Bible Lesson:

The Bible tells us that a man named John the Baptist was baptizing people by the Jordan River. Jesus came to him and asked him to baptize Him..

Read Matthew 3:13-17

What is baptism?

Remember when we washed the baby doll because she was dirty? Did you know people can also get dirty on the inside? When we disobey God, that is called sin. When we sin, it's like our insides get dirty. Yucky sin lives inside our hearts and lives. Jesu s is the only one who can wash us on the inside. When we choose to follow Jesus and make Him the Lord of our lives by becoming a Christian, He washed all our sins away! We are clean and fresh on the inside! Baptism is a symbol that shows everyone that we are clean on the inside.

Why was Jesus baptized?

Jesus wasn't dirty on the inside! He never sinned. So why did He want to be baptized? He wanted to show us an example to follow. God wants us to be baptized once we become a Christian. It shows everyone we're a Christian.

Game:

Attention Grabber:

Waiting Game - Set a timer for 1 minutes and tell the kids they have to "wait" before you can begin the lesson. Ask, Is it hard to wait sometimes? Like when you wait all year for your birthday to come or for Christmas. In today's story, we're going to hear about two people who had to wait.

Bible Lesson:

The Bible tells us that there was a man named Simeon. He was in Jerusalem. God had promised him that he would get to see Jesus before he died. But, he had to wait. Day after day, he worked, went home, went to bed, worked, went home, went to bed, worked, and day after day he waited.

One day, the Holy Spirit told him to go into the temple. He went in and there saw Mary and Joseph with baby Jesus. They had come to the temple to dedicate him to the Lord. Maybe you had were a part of a baby dedication service when you were a baby.

Well when Simeon came into the temple and saw baby Jesus, he knew exactly who He was! He took Him up into his arms and blessed God and said:

Read Luke 2:28-32.

Anna, an old widow woman, also came into the temple. She was 84 years old. She did not depart from the temple, but lived near there. Maybe she helped clean up around the temple or helped take care of the plants or flowers around the property. We don't know what all she did there, but we do know the Bible says she served God with fastings and prayers night and day.

Anna came into the temple that instant and listen to what she said and did...

Read Luke 2:38.

Anna spoke to others and told them who she had seen at the temple.

Simeon and Anna had to wait to see Jesus, but He is always worth the wait!
