

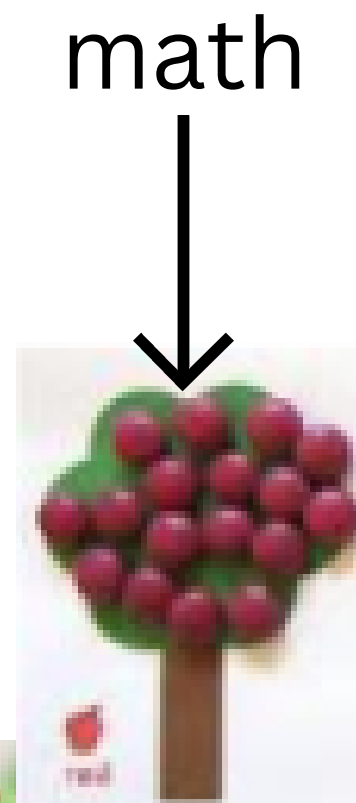

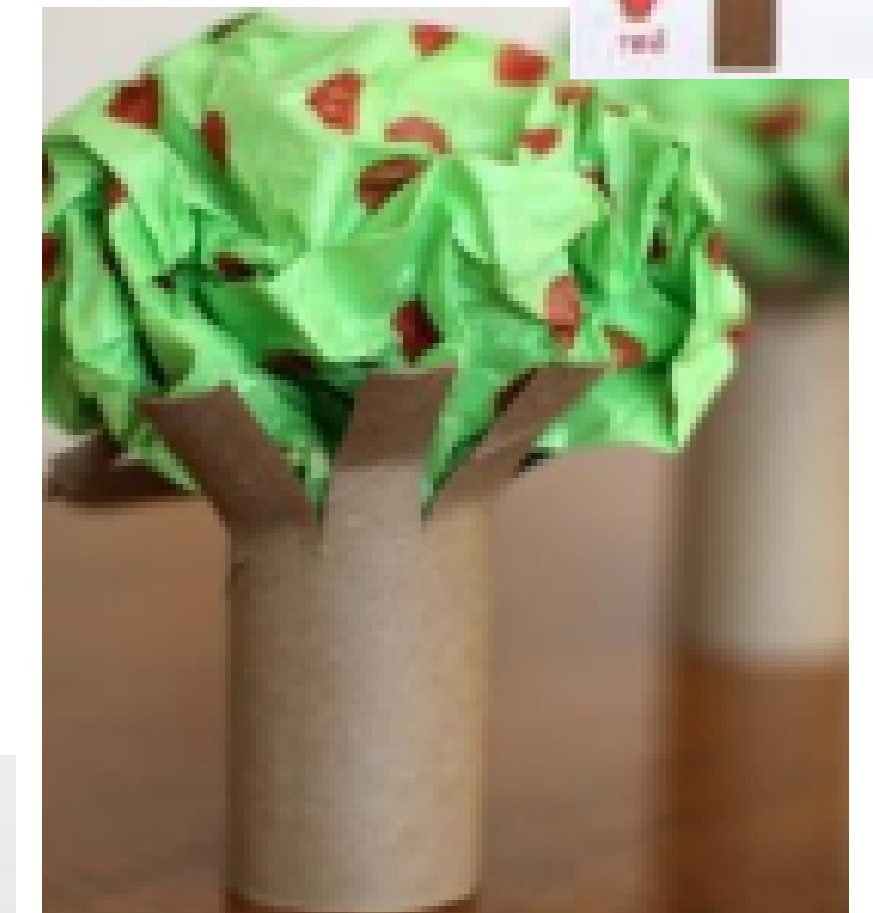
Monday –

Toilet roll, green paper, red paint, Q-tip (or use finger)



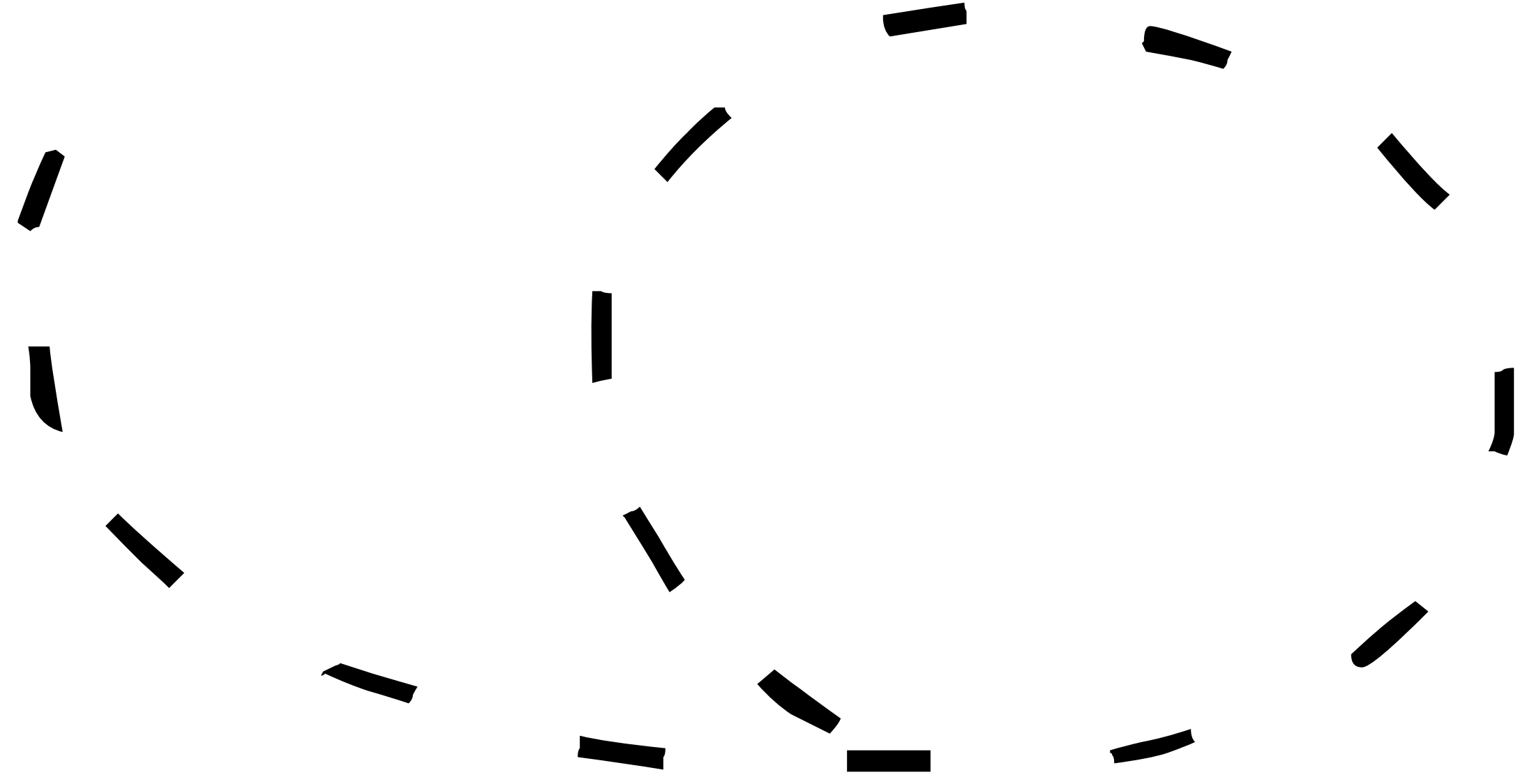
Thursday –
water, dish soap, bowl, pipe cleaner wand



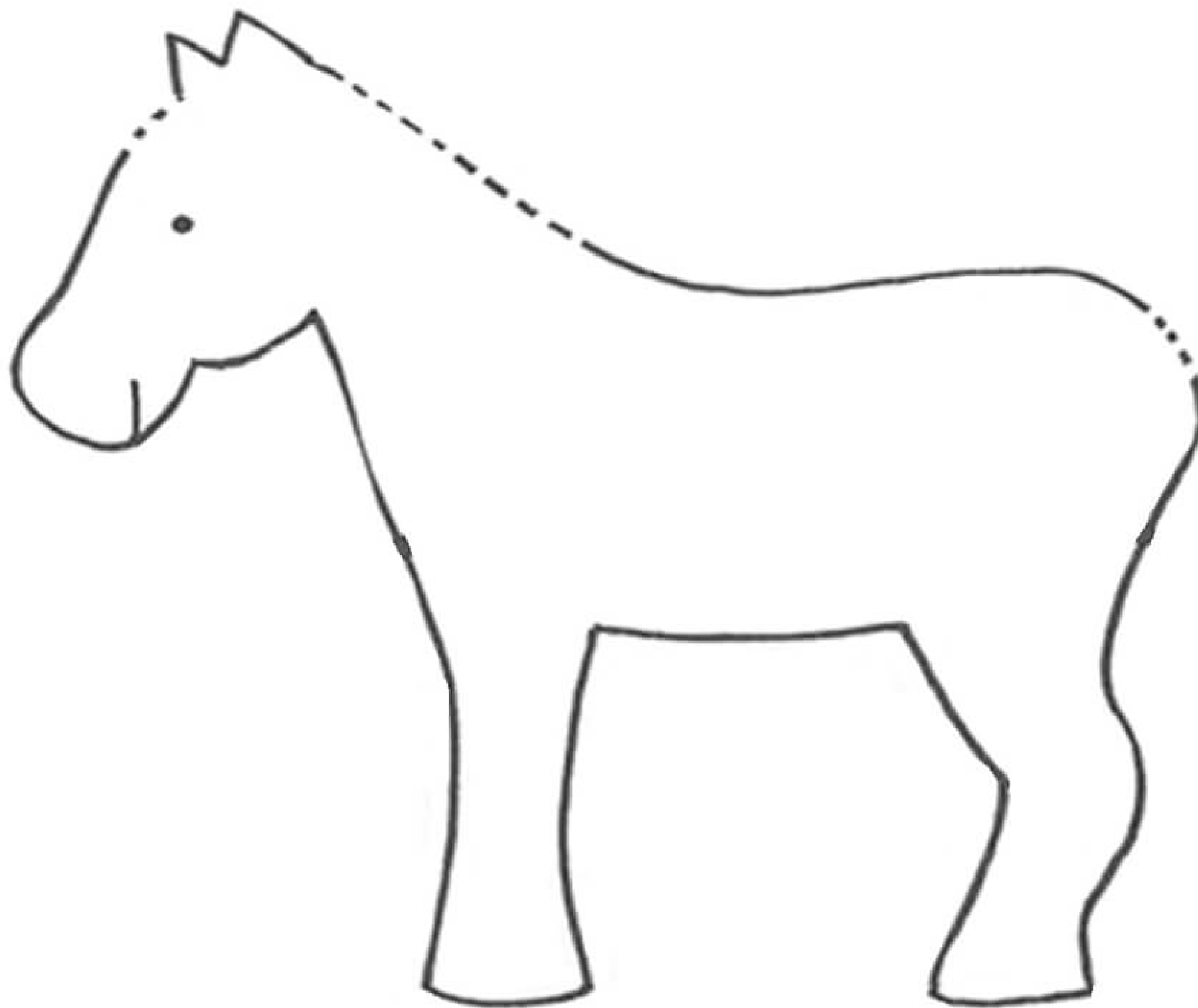

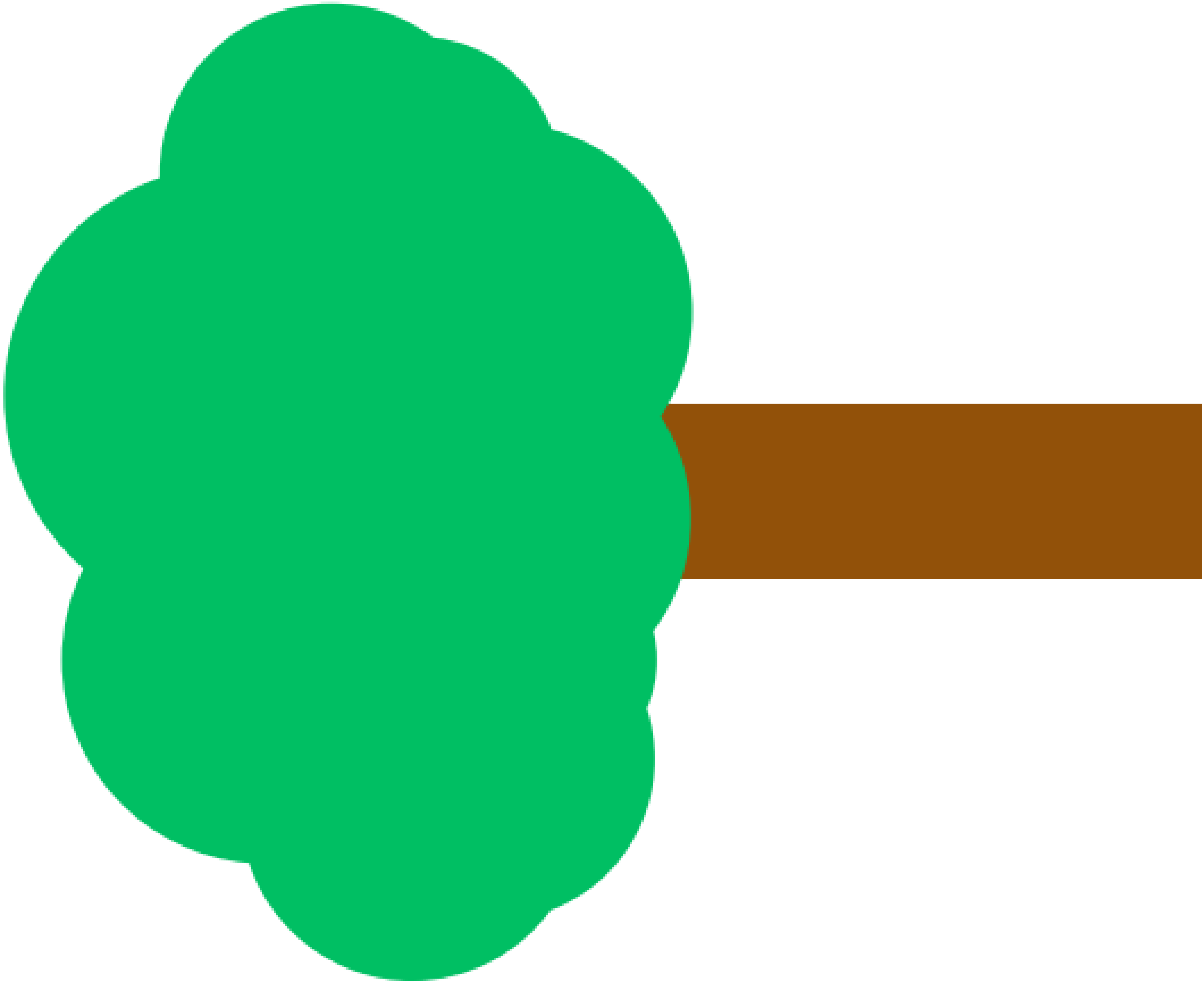


Glue yarn on top of number 6



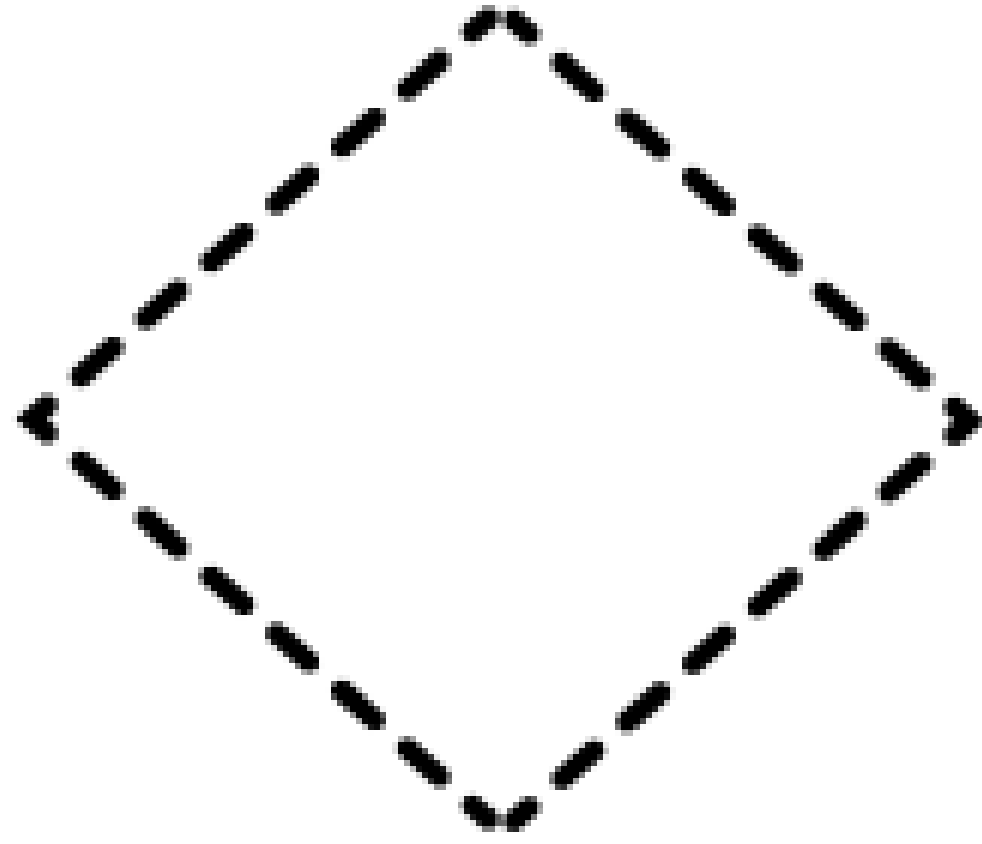
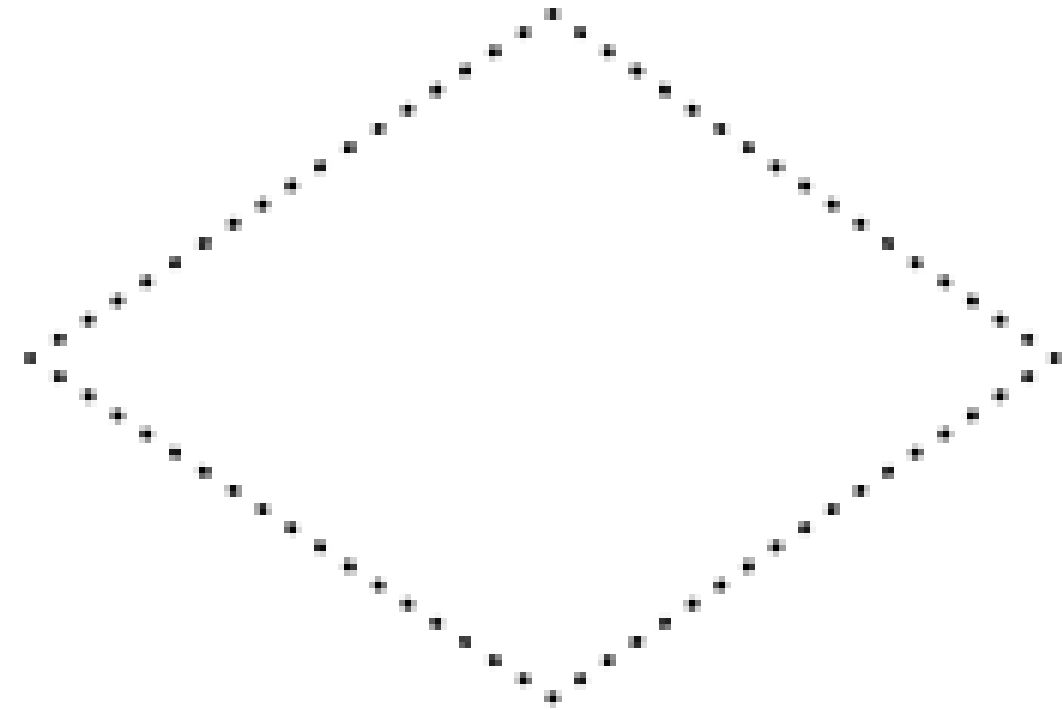
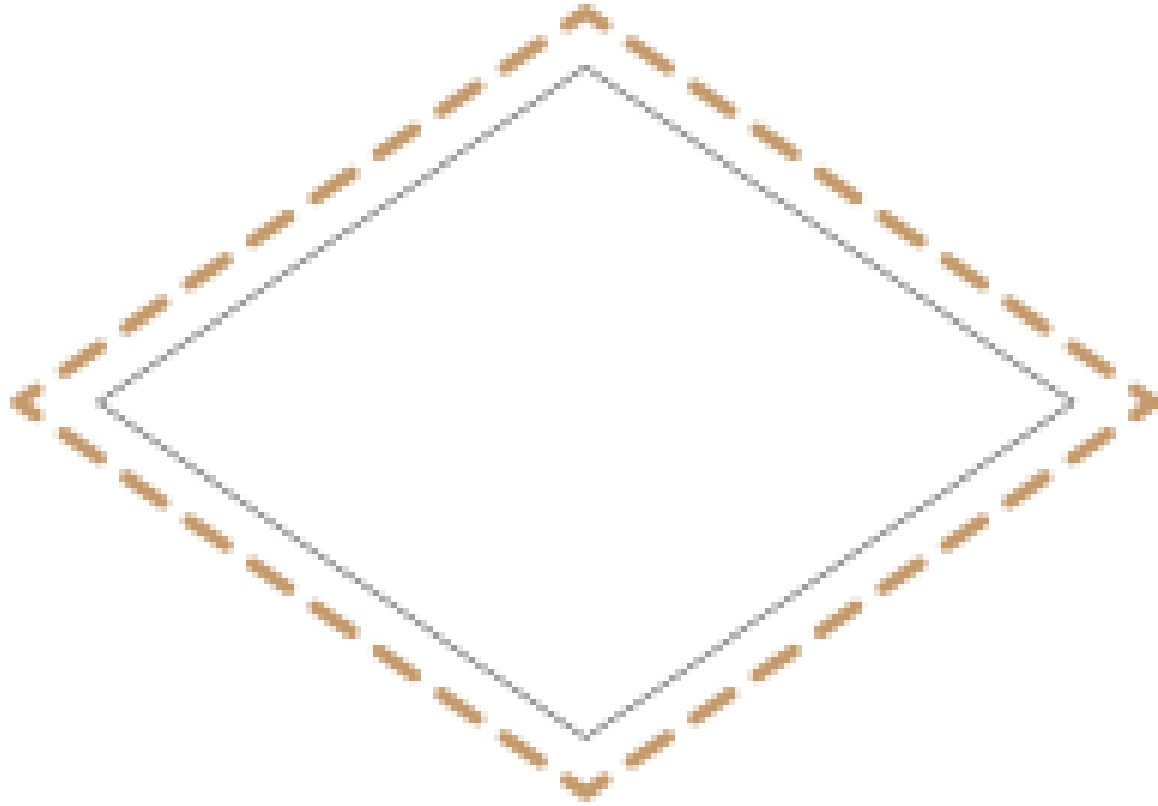
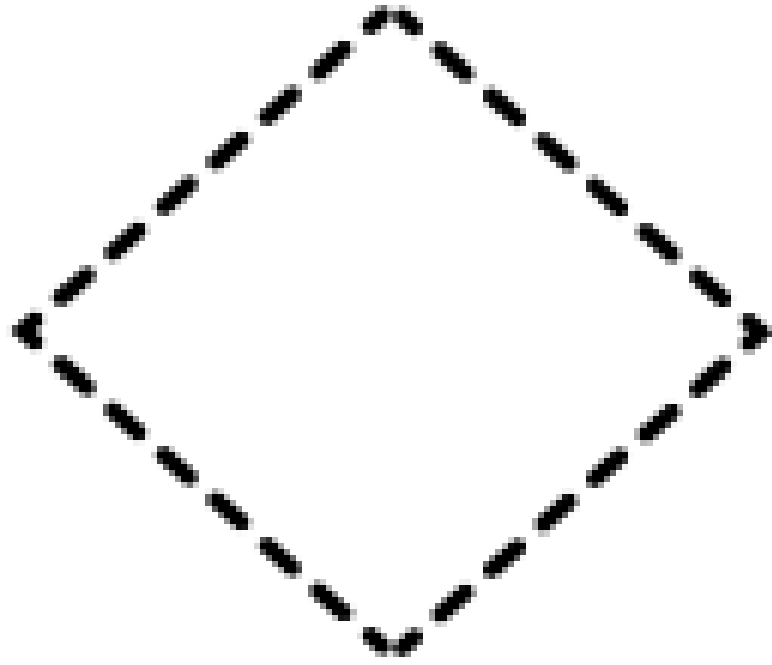
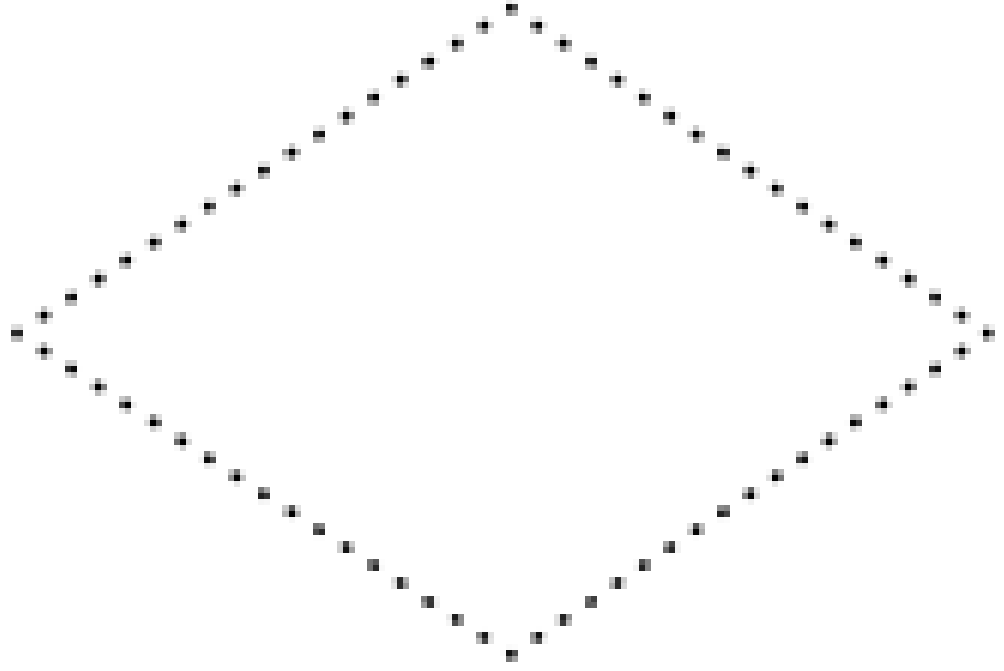
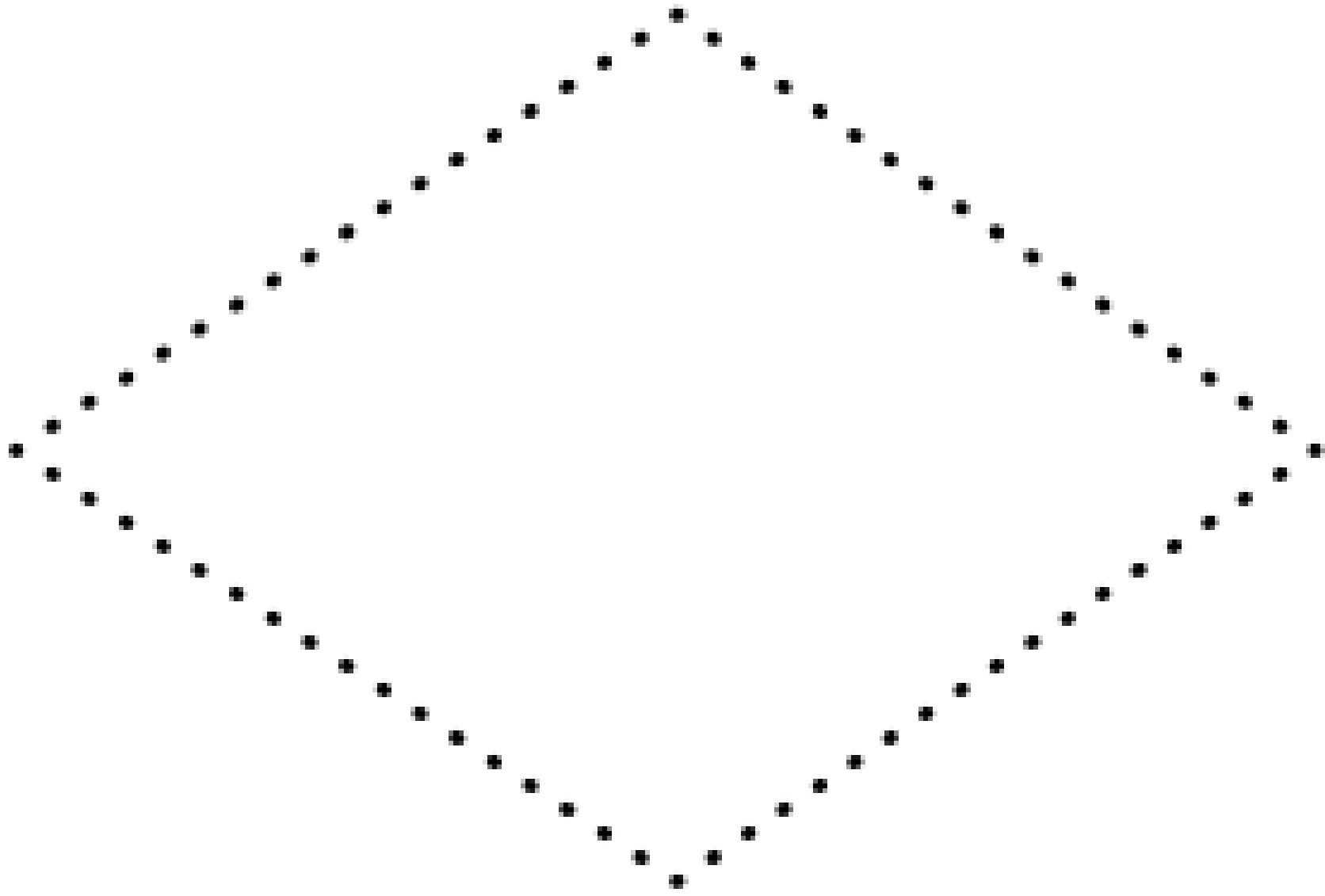
Add 6 zebra stripes

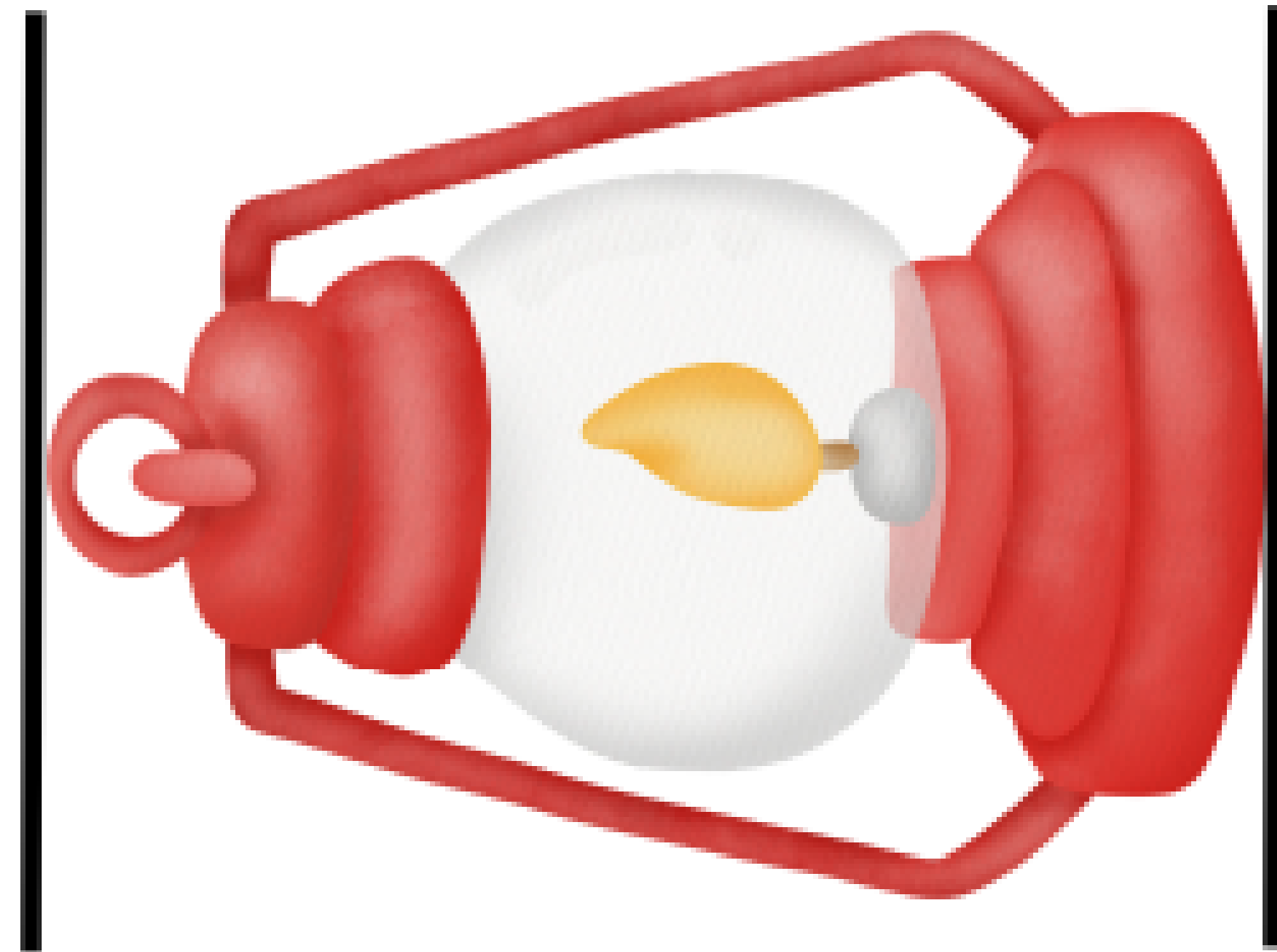
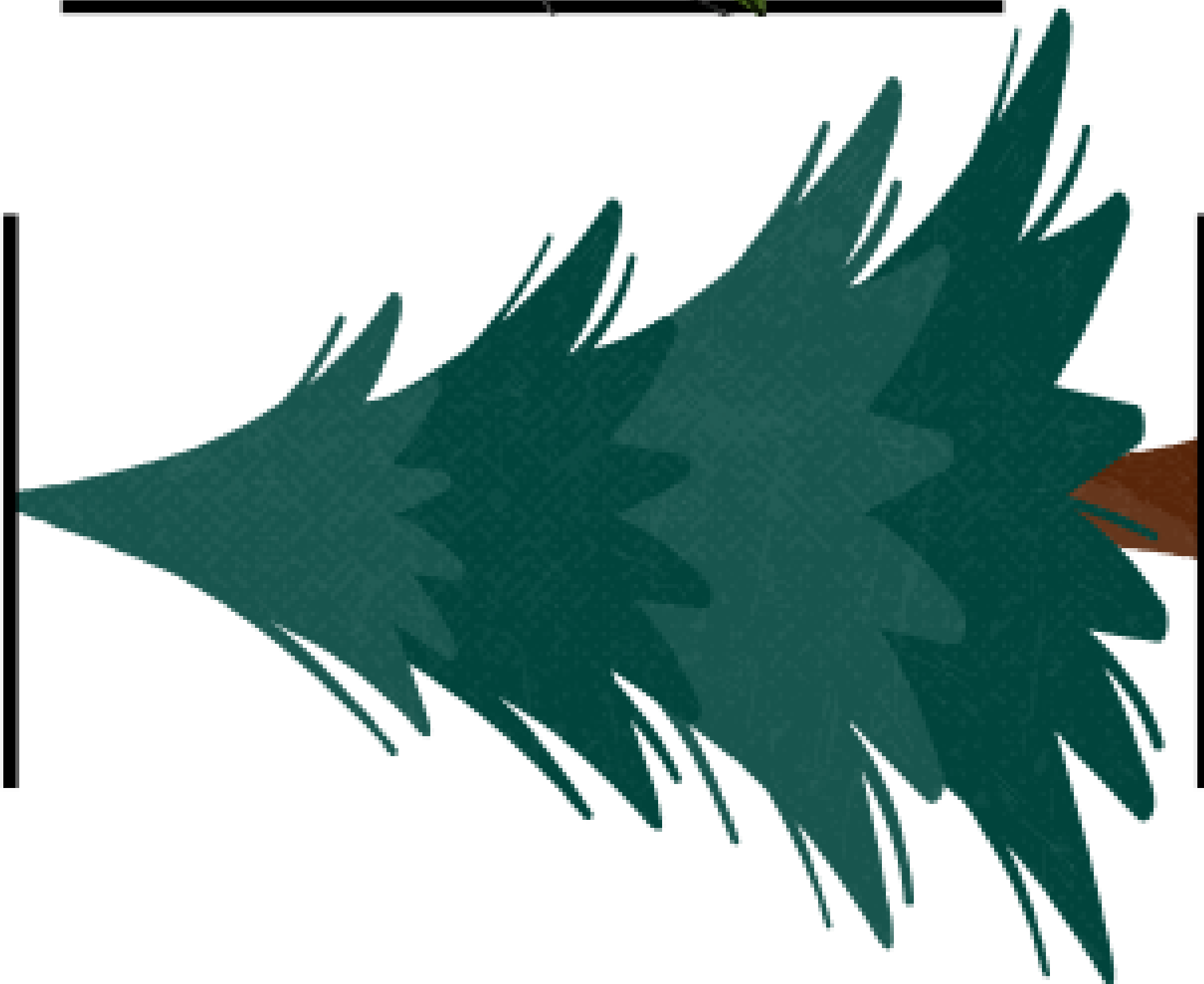
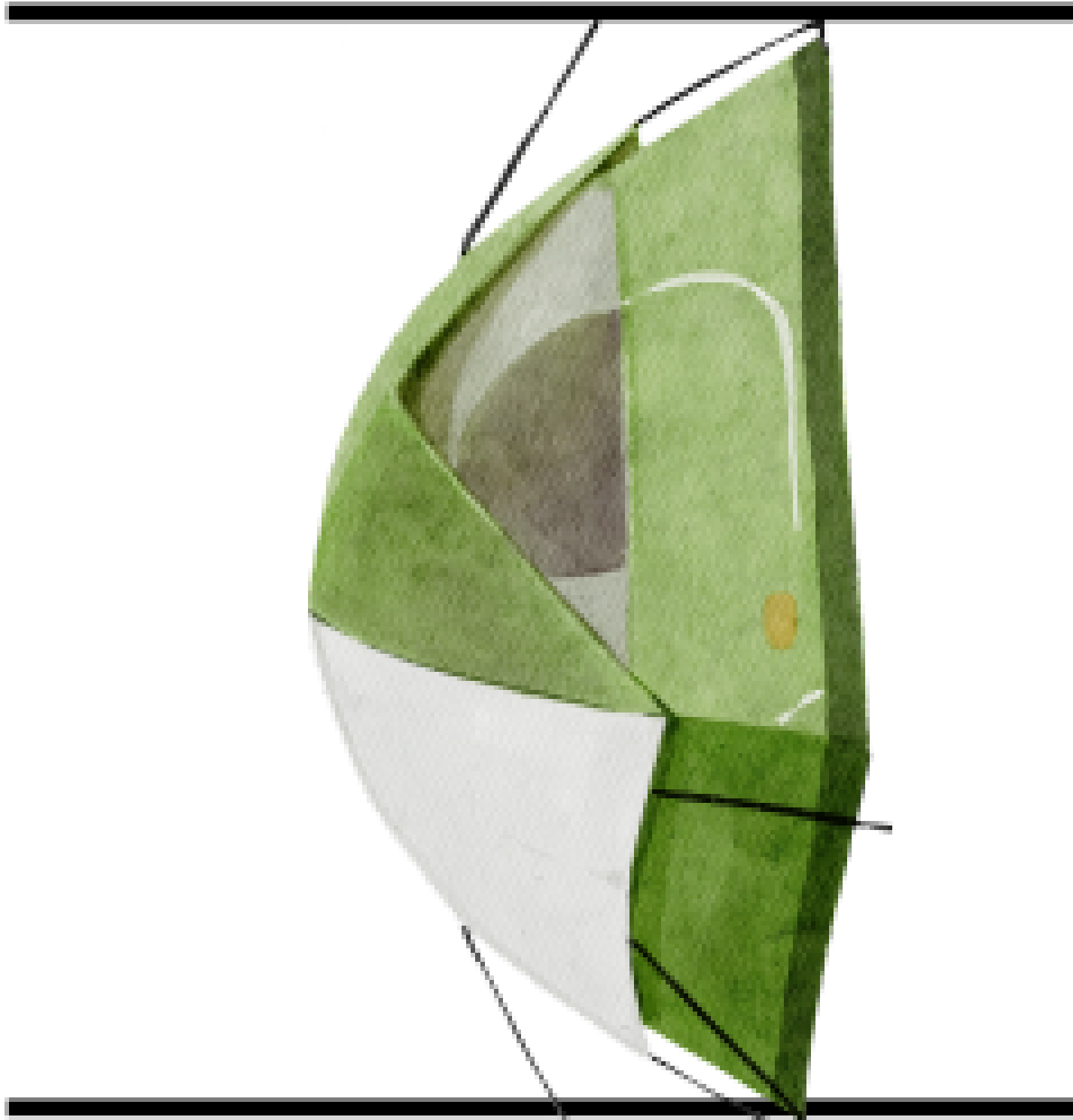




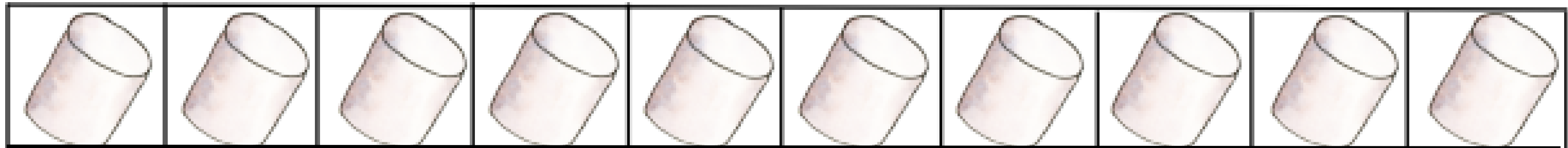
Trace the diamonds
