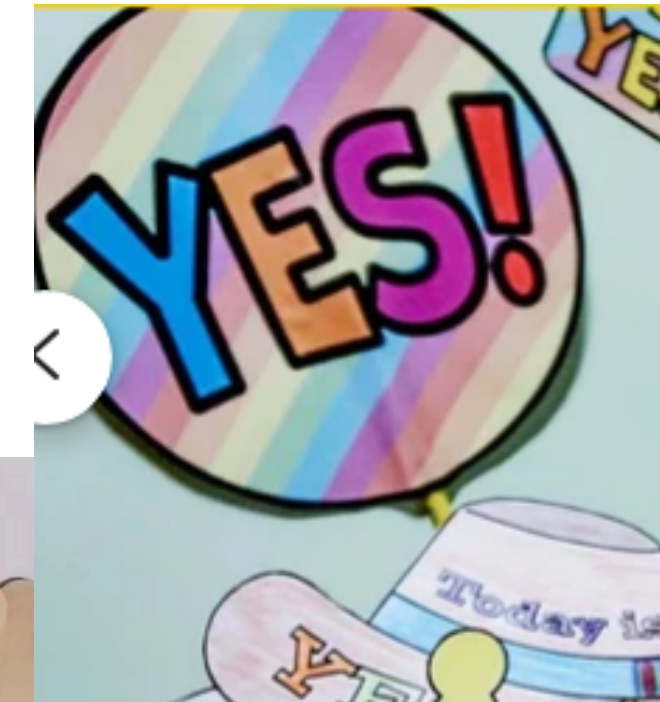

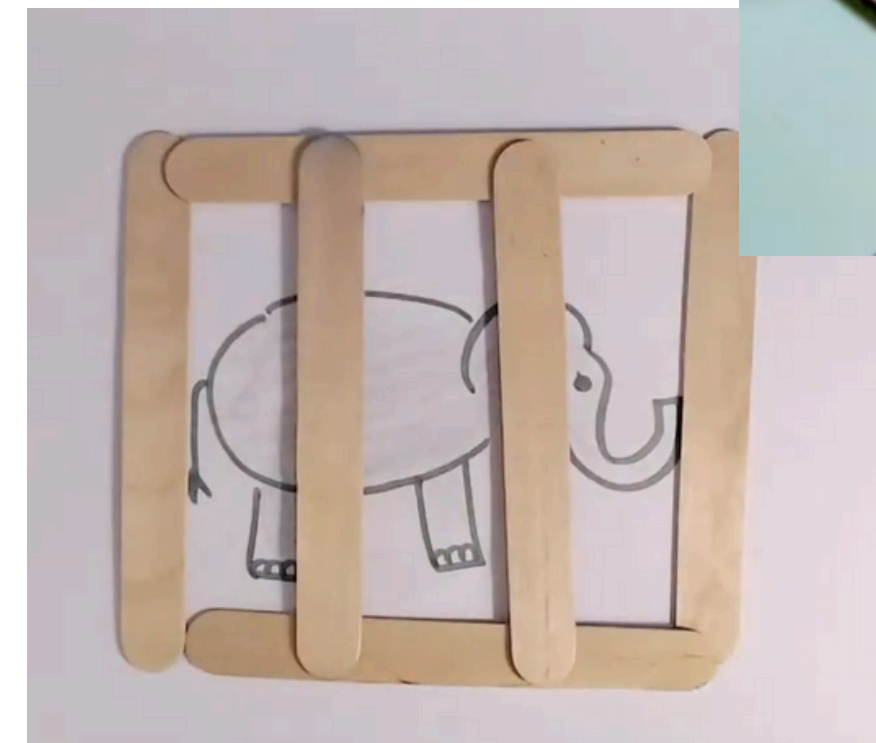
Monday – YES Sign

Paper to draw your own zoo animal, 6 popsicle sticks or strips of paper, crayons, glue



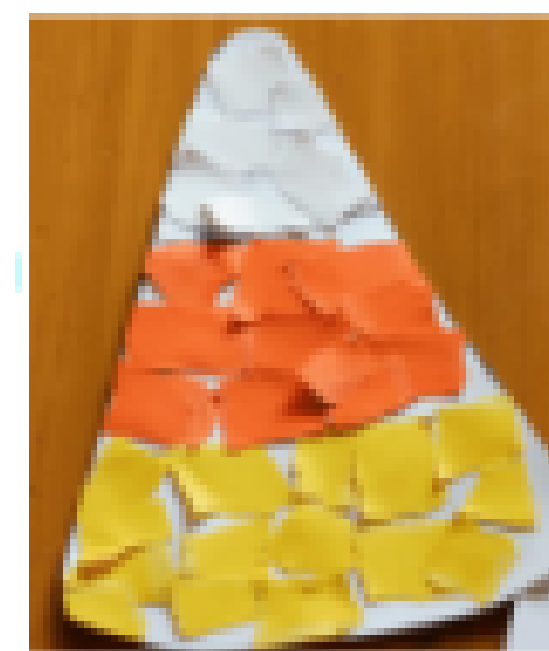
Wednesday – Giant Alligator

Friday – Toilet Roll Binoculars









2 empty toilet rolls, tape, stickers or markers to decorate (optional)

Circle or stamp the picture that completes the patterns of the zoo animals.

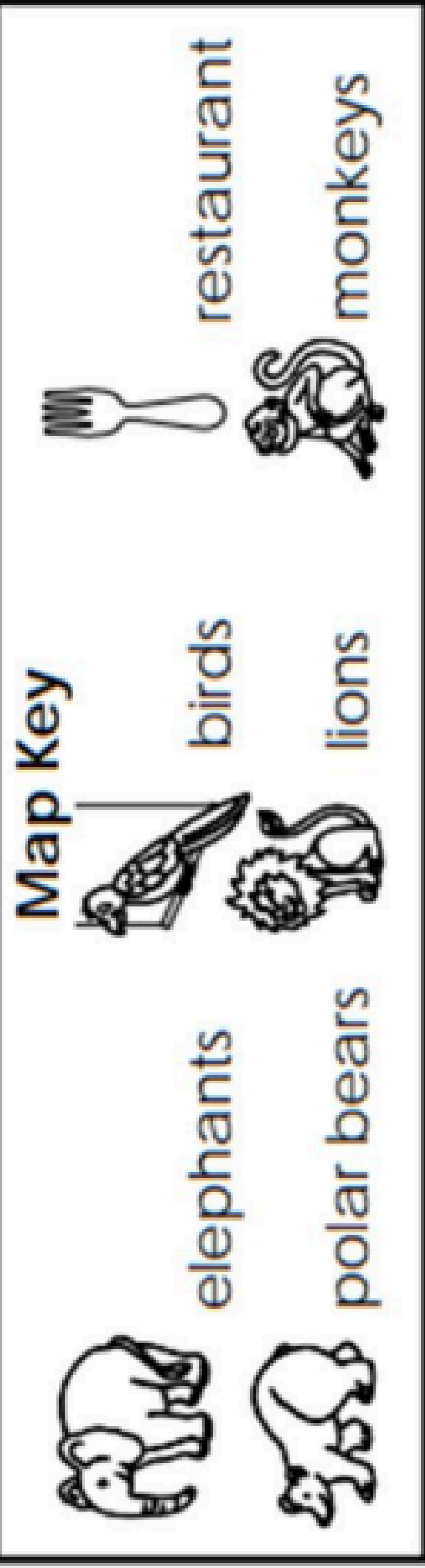
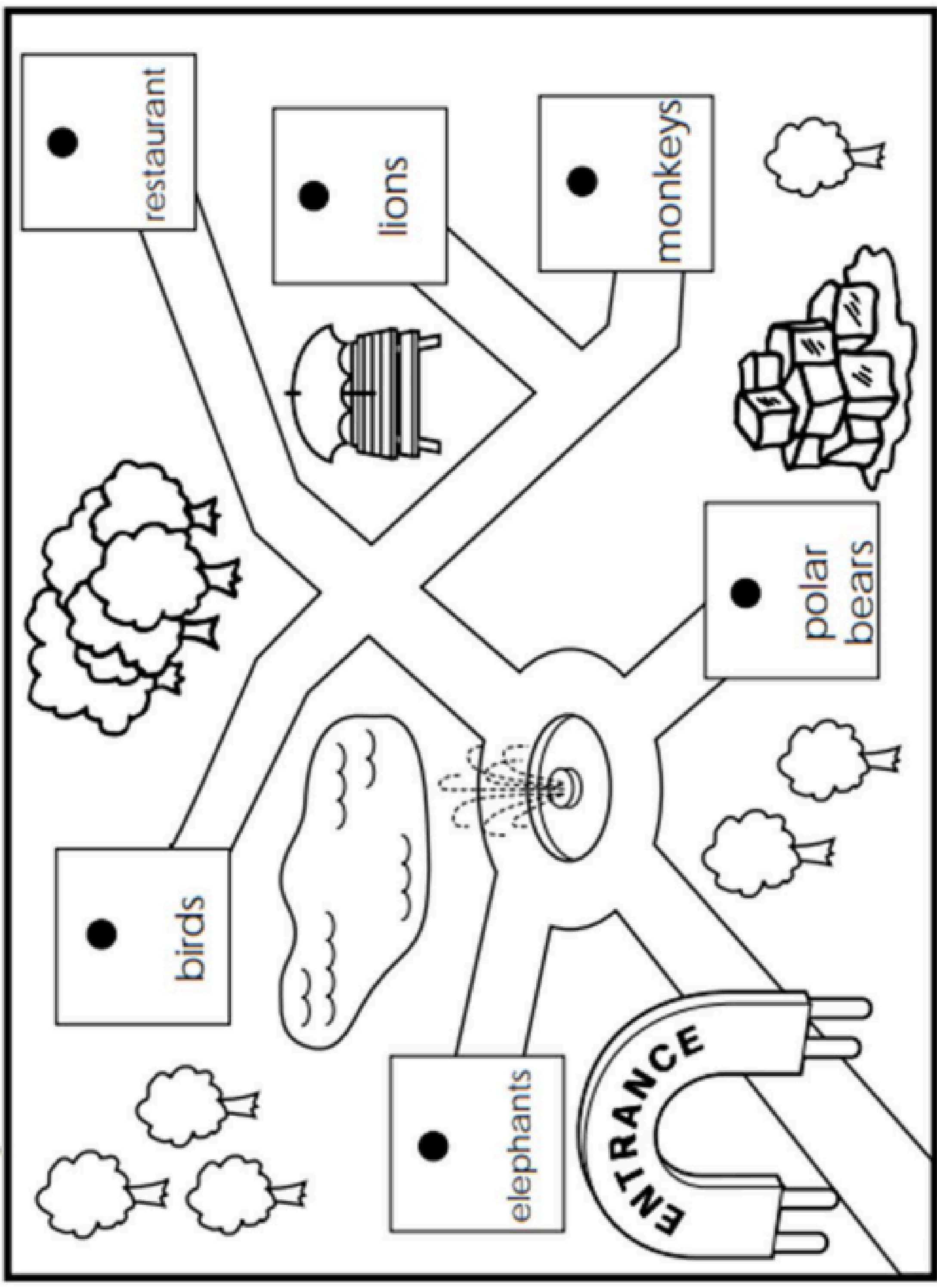
