Tuesday – Popsicle Stick Zoo Paper to draw your own zoo animal, 6 popsicle sticks or strips of paper, crayons, glue


Wednesday – Giant Alligator

Friday – Toilet Roll Binoculars2 empty toilet rolls, tape, stickers or markers todecorate (optional)







