PAUL TAUGHT TITUS

Sunday School Lesson



Create Curiosity:

Hold up a Bible and ask the kids what this book is. (The Bible) Say, The Bible is God's Word. We should read it to know what He is telling us. In the Bible it tells about an older man named, Paul. He taught a younger man named, Titus.

Show a big stuffed bear and say, This is Big Paul. Show a small stuffed bear and say, This is Little Titus. Let's play a game: When I hold up Big Paul, raise your hands up really tall. When I hold up Little Titus, put your hands down. Repeat over and over; changing the order.

Teaching Time: Titus 1 & 2

In advance, place the following items in a backpack. Pull out items one at a time and discuss.

- 1. Children's Bible:
- Big Paul taught Little Titus, "We can learn God's truth!" (Based on Titus 1:9
 teaching sound doctrine)
- 2. Reading Glasses:
- Big Paul taught Little Titus, "We can follow good examples from older people!" (Based on Titus 2:7 - being a model of good works)
- 3.Lollipop:
- Big Paul taught Little Titus, "We can have self-control!" (Based on Titus 2:6

 urging younger ones to be self-controlled)
- 4. Paper Heart:
- Big Paul taught Little Titus, "We can love others!" (Based on Titus 2:4 teaching about loving others)
- 5.Pom Pom:
- Big Paul taught Little Titus, "We can do what's right!" (Based on Titus 2:14 zealous for good works)

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Craft Corner:

Paperbag Backpack with printable items from the story inside. Children can use this to re-tell the story to their parents or caregivers when they get home from church.



Group Game:

Play the Big Paul/Little Titus game again. This time, you may want to stand up/sit down.
